The fact is that the acting secretary of national security, Chad Wolf, was allegedly appointed illegally, and was never confirmed by the Senate. This would make his actions illegal as well. Wolf issued a memo last July, limiting renewals to one year and eliminating new applications. The court ruling would benefit more than 650,000 Dreamers.
