Jim Daly: Hey, everyone, this is Jim Daly and before we get to the rest of our program today on "Focus on the Family," I want to let you know how *you* can be a voice for life and possibly stop the funding of Planned Parenthood. Senator Joni Ernst from Iowa joins us by phone and has co-sponsored a bill that would strip Planned Parenthood, which is one of the largest abortion providers in America, from receiving more than half a *billion* dollars a year from *us*, the taxpayers and that's a travesty.

Senator Joni Ernst: Right and what our legislation ensures is that funding for women's health is protected, while redirecting those taxpayer dollars away from Planned Parenthood. So we're trying to make sure those things are covered, but they're done at a community health center, at a community hospital--those that can still receive subsidized healthcare. But what we're saying is that what is done by Planned Parenthood is absolutely vile. It is reprehensible and we can't forget that. We should not be funding with taxpayer dollars an organization that lacks compassion for these mothers and their babies.

Jim: Senator, why is it important for people's voices to be heard? I mean, a lot of us are feeling beleaguered that the political system no longer really represents the values that we stand for as Christians. And we're, I think in some ways, becoming more apathetic, because we're not seeing any of the, you know, victories in this space. Why should be make the effort to call or write our senators?

Joni: It's so very important and the way our society values the most vulnerable in its population is a real strong sign or indication of where we are as a nation. And the footage detailing Planned Parenthood's role in the harvesting of organs--the heart, the liver, the kidneys of our unborn babies--is morally reprehensible and vile. The American people are horrified by this and they're horrified by the lack of compassion shown by Planned Parenthood for these women and babies. So, it is important that people reach out to their legislators and let them know that this is *not acceptable*. We are a nation that is better than this. We must do better for our mothers and our babies.

Jim: Once again, I want to say, life is not a partisan issue and like you said, this is the time to speak up for life for those innocent babies and the moms. So, call your senator and let them know that you support Senate Bill 1881 that defunds Planned Parenthood and puts dollars into clinics that are taking care of women's health issues without participating in abortion. Senator, thanks for being with us and thanks for what you 're doing.
