

WMGX COMMUNITY NEEDS 2023

THIRD QUARTER 2023 (JULY 1 – SEPTEMBER 30TH)

To address the community needs in Portland, WMGX does the following:

Maine Points: A weekly 30-minute program dealing with local issues and concerns every Sunday morning from 5:00-5:30 (below are the weekly topics).

Newscasts: 2 minutes Monday-Friday at 6am, 7am

50-60% of newscasts on WMGX deal with local issues.

Special Community Events:

We sponsor and participate in events such as fund-raisers for local non-profit organizations and charities on an on-going basis.

During the first quarter of 2023, WMGX lent support to these community events:

July 2023 – The Final Push for The Tri For A Cure – We speak with three survivors from Team FIERCE FORWARD! They are running the Tri this Sunday... and they are on The Blake Show to talk about their fundraising event at Stars and Stripes Wednesday 7/12/23 where some of the profits will go back to their fundraising goal and go to The Maine Cancer Foundation.

July 2023 – We speak with the Executive Director from The Midcoast Humane animal shelter in Brunswick, ME. They are holding a fundraiser called “Cat Naps And Doggie Dreams”. A few people are selected to sleep in the shelter overnight and they raise money from family, friend and the general public to benefit the shelter animals.

August 2023 – We speak with Travis Mills to discuss the Plane Pull benefiting the Travis Mills Foundation. It takes place on October 28th at the Portland International Jetport. Each team is required to raise \$2500 to be eligible to pull the plane on event day. Last year raised \$270K for recalibrated vets served by The Travis Mills Foundation. We also talk about The 3rd Annual Building Strength Gala. A signature event for the Travis Mills Foundation.

August 2023 – We speak with Aaron Libby from Libby & Son U Picks from Limerick, Maine! They are up for the best Apple Orchard in the United States! This contest is from USA Today, and they came in talked about local farming, picking fruit and their upcoming apple picking season.

August 2023 – We speak with Leslie Clark from The Portland Recovery Center. She comes on the show to talk about Recovery Month and to talk about the Rally 4 Recovery that takes place on September 10. It is Southern Maine’s largest recovery event – and celebrates their mission which is to provide support, education, resources and advocacy for people recovering from and affected by addiction.

August 2023 – Throughout the entire month of August we have been highlighting Teachers! We have them upload a video telling us where they teach, what grade and then they also upload their amazon wish list. We talk about them on the show, post them on social media and we try to get our listeners to clear their lists for their classrooms.

September 2023 – We speak with Kevin On The Roof! He is yet again on the roof of a car dealership to raise money for STRIVE! STRIVE is an organization helps kids and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. This is his 11th year! And after raising \$60K last year, he is trying to raise \$65K! When we spoke to him, he had already raised close to \$13K

September 2023 – We speak with Bridget who has a child who is part of the Maine Children’s Cancer Program. Blake will be hosting the Maine Children’s Cancer Program Walk on Saturday 9/16. The walk has been going on for 36 years and has enabled communities statewide to gather and walk in support of local children fighting cancer and blood disorders.

September 2023 – We speak with Melissa & Erin from Northern Light Health about the McAuley Walk/Run for Recovery. It’s a 5K to help the women and children of McAuley Residence – a program of Northern Light Mercy Hospital that provides critical support, counseling and safe housing to women in recovery and their children.

7/16/23 Maine Points: Agassiz Village

Agassiz Village was founded in 1935 at its present lakeside location in Poland Maine by Mr. & Mrs. Harry E. Burroughs. Then, as now, Agassiz gave children the opportunity to escape the hardship of their daily lives. Originally the camp served boys who worked as newsboys, bootblacks, or other street vendors. The boys learned basic job skills, practiced school subjects, experienced outdoor living, and developed many life skills. The camp opened its doors to an adaptive program for physically disabled campers in the late 1950's, and girls joined the camp in 1973 when it became coed. Campers come from all over the New England area to experience this unique program. Today, Agassiz Village serves nearly 500 children a summer. While we welcome all children ages 8–17, our focus is reaching children in Maine and Massachusetts from under-resourced communities. www.agassizvillage.org

7/23/23 Maine Points: Bill Dodge Auto Group

It's a locally-conceived, locally-built, unmanned, pantry on wheels that can be moved from place to place as needed. 8/6/23 Maine Points: Maine GearShare

Maine GearShare began as an idea in 2017 when local outdoor-focused foundations had started recognizing a pattern of requests for gear and equipment to help connect more young people to the outdoors. Upon digging into the need further, many trip leading organizations identified that gear acquisition, inventorying, maintenance, and repair, played a major role in their operational costs and capabilities to extend services to more participants. This begged the question, could we come up with a better solution using the gear library concept?

Maine GearShare gained significant traction as demand for safe outdoor experiences has skyrocketed. With the securing of input from dozens of trip leading organizations in Maine, and funding and resources from the Quimby Family Foundation, the Onion Foundation, the Outdoor Foundation, and Maine Outdoor Brands, Maine GearShare incorporated in 2021, formed a Board of Directors, and hired its first staff members. In 2022, Maine GearShare found a physical space

in Brunswick, acquired a gear inventory, and officially launched its gear sharing service in May.
