

Political Advertising Disclosure Statement

Section 399B(b)(2) of the Communications Act of 1934 prohibits non-commercial, educational radio stations from accepting commercial advertising. The Federal Communications Commission regulation states: "No public broadcast station may make its facilities available to any person for the broadcasting of any advertisement." The statute defines "advertisement" as a message or program that is broadcast in exchange for remuneration and that promotes

- "any service, facility, or product offered by any person who is engaged in such offering for profit"
- or advocates the views of a given person on some matter of public interest
- or takes a stand on a candidate for public office

In accordance with this regulation, KCEA-FM does not accept political advertising.
