## Section I - Issues

- ISSUE 4 **Foster Care/Adoption** There are hundreds of children living in foster care across East Texas. In addition, May is Foster Care Awareness Month. We talk with the Hope Haven organization from East Texas which is a home for young to teenage girls who can't find a foster family or haven't been adopted.
- ISSUE 5 **Animal Neglect** Horse neglect in East Texas is an all too common problem, and local government is not equipped to adequately investigate cruelty complaints. Pegasus Project relationship with the SPCA of East Texas, along with Allyson's legal expertise, makes it uniquely situated to move quickly and serve as an immediate advocate for horses in need.
