Community groups, civic organizations, nonprofits, school or church-based groups in West Central Minnesota are encouraged to apply for a Community Spotlight grant. KLFN and our co-sponsor Paffrath and Son Jewelers provide the grant. Grant recipients receive a month-long radio advertising campaign on KLFN valued at \$2,738. In January 2023, United Way of West Central Minnesota was featured.

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<p>Encouraging people to donate cash and nonperishable food items during MN Food Share month to benefit the Kandiyohi County Food Shelf.</p>	<p>KLFN teamed up with the Kandiyohi County Food Shelf and our three other radio stations to make a big push for donations in March. March is MN Food Share Month where they can receive some special grants. This was our 18th anniversary of a March live broadcast to benefit the Kandiyohi County Food Shelf.</p>	<p>From February 22, 2023 through March 24, 2023, KLFN aired promos about Radio For Relief to benefit the Kandiyohi County Food Shelf. They mentioned the fact that they can take a donation of \$20 and purchase almost \$200 worth of food. We created an informational letter about Radio For Relief and sent it to our clients and area schools. From February 22, 2023 until March 24th, we encouraged people to start setting aside their cash and food donations for our Radio For Relief event on March 24th. We invited Jennie-O Turkey Store to be a corporate partner with us for Radio For Relief as another way to increase the amount raised. Our morning shows featured interviews and stories about the Kandiyohi County Food Shelf. This year's total was \$79,983 dollars and 1,981 pounds collected. This is a huge help for their mission of helping local individuals and families. The total Radio For Relief combined cash and food donations is \$798,297 and pounds of food collected since 2006.</p>

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Sharing information about an Amber Alert issued.	KLFN was contacted with Amber Alert information from the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension's Crime Alert Network.	On February 24, 2023, KLFN broadcast the information one time and was later informed by the MN BCA that the child from Lakeville, Minnesota, the subject of the Amber Alert had been found safe and as of 2:56 PM the Alert was cancelled.
