REPRESENTATIVE LISTING OF OUR PROGRAMING TO MEET COMMUNITY NEEDS

1. ISSUE/TOPIC: Helping the Disabled

PROGRAM: Joni and Friends, June 10, 2022; 8:00am

DESCRIPTION: God asks you to not only remember the afflicted, but to do something about their plight. On this broadcast Joni Tada shares about the opportunities that her ministry has had in Europe. They have offered Family Retreats to Ukrainian refugees that have disabled family members. It has been a blessing to encourage these people with a little hope during these difficult times.

2. ISSUE/TOPIC: When Providence brings Pain

PROGRAM: Revive our Hearts, April 18, 2022; 9:00-9:30am DESCRIPTION: If God is all good and all powerful, why does He let us experience pain and suffering? Bob Lepine takes us to the Scriptures to help us learn to trust God, even when His providence brings pain.
