REPRESENTATIVE LISTING OF OUR PROGRAMING TO MEET COMMUNITY NEEDS

1. ISSUE/TOPIC: Unfulfilled longings

PROGRAM: Revive our Hearts, October 12, 2022; 9:00-9:30am

DESCRIPTION: Guest speaker Kristen Clark shared with listeners her journey with infertility and unfulfilled longings. She encouraged us to open our hands and surrender that area of our life to Him in a deeper way. She shared the truth that: true joy and fulfillment doesn't come from getting what you want but from surrendering your entire life to what God wants and trusting that His plan is truly good.

2. ISSUE/TOPIC: Shame

PROGRAM: Point of View, December 17, 2022; 11:05am-1:00pm

DESCRIPTION: Listeners joined Kerby as he talked with psychiatrist and author Dr. Curt Thompson about his book "The Soul of Shame". It follows up on the research and discoveries he made in his first book, Anatomy of the Soul, by unpacking shame, revealing its ubiquitous nature and neurobiological roots and describing the affect it has on our souls. He also provides the theological and practical tools necessary to dismantle shame based on years of researching its damaging effects and counseling people to overcome those wounds.

3. ISSUE/TOPIC: Calling rulers to Repentance

PROGRAM: Grace to You, October 12, 2022; 7:30-8:00pm

DESCRIPTION: After California's governor recently had billboards put up in politically conservative states, encouraging women there to come to California for abortions, John MacArthur wrote an open letter to the governor, and then—on this program he preached the message that we're interrupting our regular schedule to air. Listeners were challenged by the message "Calling Rulers to Repentance."

4. ISSUE/TOPIC: Obedience

PROGRAM: Joni and Friends, October 19, 2022; 8:00am

DESCRIPTION: When it comes to obeying God, it takes courage to just do it! By reading his Word, you already know what he is asking of you, so stop dragging your feet and do whatever he's asked you to do.

5. ISSUE/TOPIC: Ice Age

PROGRAM: Answers in Genesis, December 5, 2022, 3:28pm

DESCRIPTION: Mammoths, woolly rhinos, and giant glaciers all bring to mind an ice age. But did such an event really happen? Yes! The evidence is overwhelming. Host Ken Ham shared the truths about the Ice Age on this broadcast of Answers in Genesis.

6. ISSUE/TOPIC: Crisis of Men and Boys

PROGRAM: Viewpoints Commentary, October 13, 2022; 11:15am

DESCRIPTION: Commentator Kerby Anderson explains the crisis of men and boys as a well-known and well documented fact. His radio interviews with Dr. Warren Farrell about his book, *The Boy Crisis* is but one example. Jordan Peterson has been speaking and writing about his concerns for many years. The latest warning comes from a David Brooks op-ed in the *New York Times* and the publication of a new book by Richard Reeves, *Of Boys and Men*. He concluded that these authors did a good job of identifying the problems but could not offer a solution to a society still searching for a "modern masculine ideal." Therefore, pastors and men in the church need to provide a biblical foundation for manhood and must teach it to the boys and men in the church. We need a biblical answer to a major crisis in our culture.

7. ISSUE/TOPIC: Burdens

PROGRAM: Love worth Finding, October 28, 2022; 8:00-8:30pm

DESCRIPTION: Whether we are saved or lost, we will all carry burdens at points in our lives; but we do not have to bear them alone. On this broadcast Pastor Rogers spoke from Galatians 6 to show us what to do with our burdens.

8. ISSUE/TOPIC: Why do Tragedies Happen

PROGRAM: Answers in Genesis, October 26, 2022; 9:00-9:30am

DESCRIPTION: During Christ's day, a tower collapsed, killing eighteen people. When Jesus spoke of this event, he gave an answer to the question of why God allows tragedies but it's maybe not the answer you expect. Bad things that happen to people aren't always related to personal sin. But all of us suffer and die because of sin. Instead of blaming God for tragedies, Jesus says we need to repent and turn to the only one who can save us from eternal suffering—himself.

9. ISSUE/TOPIC: Freedom from sorrow

PROGRAM: Joni and Friends, October 6, 2022, 8:00am

DESCRIPTION: Although you may be enduring a fiery trial today, you can walk through that trial! There is no need to try to solve it in order to get back on the path forward – it is the path forward, to the heart of Jesus. Joni encouraged listeners to remember that Jesus is with you in the midst of every trial, walking alongside you.

10. ISSUE/TOPIC: How to find a church

PROGRAM: Grace to You, November 14, 2022; 7:30-8:00pm

DESCRIPTION: How do you decide which church is right for you and your family—what do you look for? Denomination? Music style? Location? Service time? Listeners learned what you should prioritize in John MacArthur's study What to Look for in a Church.

11. **ISSUE/TOPIC: Spiritual Gifts**

PROGRAM: Love worth Finding, October 14, 2022, 8:00-8:30pm

DESCRIPTION: When we are born again and become children of God, we receive spiritual gifts. Discovering, developing, and putting to work our spiritual gifts is how we find joy and fulfillment in the Christian life. If you haven't discovered your spiritual gifts, ask yourself: Have I presented myself to the Lord? Have I decided to be a good steward of whatever the Holy Spirit has confirmed in me? Am I serving faithfully in my church? Pastor Adrian Rogers unpacks this important topic on this broadcast of Love worth Finding.

12. **ISSUE/TOPIC: Digital Discernment**

PROGRAM: Viewpoints Commentary, December 27, 2022; 11:15am

DESCRIPTION: Commentator Kerby Anderson shares that Technology makes our lives easier, but digital technology can also make our lives more complicated. Over the last two decades, we have seen the rise of misinformation, polarization, and conspiracy theories. How can we navigate a world where so much information is coming at us at light speed? Kerby told listeners about a new book, Following Jesus in a Digital Age. In this book the author challenges us to consider how social media is shaping our worldviews and then apply biblical wisdom to navigate the difficult terrain of our digital culture.
