REPRESENTATIVE LISTING OF OUR PROGRAMING TO
MEET COMMUNITY NEEDS

1. ISSUE/TOPIC: Forgiveness

PROGRAM: Revive our Hearts, July 11, 2022; 9:00-9:30am

DESCRIPTION: Listeners were encouraged with this series on forgiveness taught by Nancy DeMoss Wolgemuth. She says, “One of the things that has helped me the most is to realize that forgiveness is not a feeling. Forgiveness is not emotion. Forgiveness, ultimately, is a choice. It’s an act of my will.” Nancy going to help listeners understand forgiveness from the perspective of the Bible. You might be surprised at what God’s Word says—and doesn’t say—about the subject.

2. ISSUE/TOPIC: Intelligent Design

PROGRAM: Point of View, July 7, 2022; 11:05am-1:00pm

DESCRIPTION: Host Kerby Anderson interviewed Dr. Stephen Jacoboni. As an oncologist and researcher, Stephen told us about his new book, *Telos: The Scientific Basis for a Life of Purpose*. He exposed scientists’ atheism lies and shared the scientific proof of intelligent design and existence.

3. ISSUE/TOPIC: Anxiety Free Living

PROGRAM: Grace to You, July 13, 2022; 7:30-8:00pm

DESCRIPTION: When money is tight, when health is poor, when a relationship is strained—when your world seems to be falling apart—how do you keep from worrying about it? Listeners were encouraged to find genuine peace even during the hardest times as John MacArthur shared his message on *Anxiety-Free Living*.

4. ISSUE/TOPIC: Biblical Friendship

PROGRAM: Joni and Friends, August 15, 2022; 8:00am

DESCRIPTION: Biblical friendship means loving your friends sacrificially, as Jesus loves you. Radio host Joni Tada encouraged listeners to look for ways to love your friends well today by first putting Jesus at the center of it all.

5. ISSUE/TOPIC: Critical Race Theory

PROGRAM: Answers in Genesis, August 22, 2022, 3:28pm

DESCRIPTION: Many in our culture are trying to address the issue of racism by applying critical race theory, or CRT. This is the belief that racism is part of the air we breathe, and those who are part of the “white” race can’t escape being racist—it’s part of who they are. But we need to stop right there. This premise is flawed because there’s only one race! You see, the Bible teaches we’re all descended from Adam, so we’re all one race. And science confirms this! The differences between people groups are very minor—they make up just a fraction of our DNA. Yet CRT says what you look like on the outside is all that matters. But God looks, not on the outside, but on the heart.

6. ISSUE/TOPIC: Pain

PROGRAM: Joni and Friends, September 7, 2022; 8:00am

DESCRIPTION: How can you display faith in God when you are suffering? Program host Joni Tada encouraged listeners that when you are in the midst of pain, direct your questions and doubts to God, not out of spite but out of trust. And like the psalmists, always follow up your questions by anchoring your hopes to the promises of God.

7. ISSUE/TOPIC: Rescue the Perishing

PROGRAM: Love worth Finding, July 26, 2022; 8:00-8:30pm

DESCRIPTION: In this message from Jude 22-23, Adrian Rogers shares the compassion, compulsion, and caution we need as we win souls for Christ.

8. ISSUE/TOPIC: Comfort

PROGRAM: Revive our Hearts, August 26, 2021; 9:00-9:30am

DESCRIPTION: The host today interviewed songwriter Keith Getty on the importance of teaching our children theology through hymns and how that can come back later as a comfort when going through rough times.

9. ISSUE/TOPIC: When Sorrow Runs Deep

PROGRAM: Joni and Friends, August 30, 2022, 8:00am

DESCRIPTION: When you are inconsolable, God reaches you in your grief and pain. Sometimes he even reaches you through a comforting hymn. . . “Come, ye disconsolate, where'er ye languish; come to the mercy seat, fervently kneel. Here, bring your wounded heart, here tell all your anguish; Earth has no sorrow that heaven cannot heal.” Those stanzas are, well, they're for the inconsolable – when sorrow runs so deep it can only be eased by the strong arm of all three Persons of the Trinity. If you are in a season of pain and suffering, remember that all three Persons of the Trinity are for you: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. You are not alone!

10. ISSUE/TOPIC: How to Live for God's Glory

PROGRAM: Grace to You, September 20, 2022; 7:30-8:00pm

DESCRIPTION: As a Christian, your life is a lamp designed for one purpose: to glorify God by reflecting His light in a dying world. But specifically, how do you do that? John MacArthur helps you answer that question as he gives a step-by-step approach for *How to Live for God's Glory*.

11. **ISSUE/TOPIC:** Eternal Security

PROGRAM: Love worth Finding, July 9, 2022, 8:00-8:30pm

DESCRIPTION: We do not have to live in fear of losing our salvation. Listeners were encouraged as they listened to this message in which Adrian Rogers shared the believer's security in uncertain days.

12. **ISSUE/TOPIC:** Soft totalitarianism

PROGRAM: Viewpoints Commentary, August 19, 2022; 11:15am

DESCRIPTION: Commentator Kerby Anderson discusses the book *Live not by lies* by Rod Dreher. In that book the author warns Christians about the coming "soft totalitarianism." He explains that this is different from what we read in novels like *Brave New World* or in *Nineteen Eighty-Four*. The old, hard totalitarianism came from the state (Germany, Russia) and was dedicated to the eradication of Christianity. This new totalitarianism usually comes from the left in society but is also dedicated to the eradication of Christianity. Mr. Anderson went on to explain the soft totalitarianism of today demands allegiance to a set of progressive beliefs. Compliance is forced less by the state than by elites who form public opinion and by private corporations that control our lives through technology. Citizens won't be taken away in handcuffs by the state, but their lives will be devastated by leftist elites that will do what they can to destroy their lives. Mr. Dreher's book is full of stories from Christians who endured hard totalitarianism, and provides us with models for how to address this more insidious form of soft totalitarianism. We are seeing more examples each week of how leftist elites are changing American society.
