REPRESENTATIVE LISTING OF OUR PROGRAMING TO MEET COMMUNITY NEEDS

1. ISSUE/TOPIC: Border Crisis

PROGRAM: Viewpoints Commentary, January 9, 2023; 11:15am

DESCRIPTION: Most Americans do not know how bad the border crisis is, and that may also explain why the recent omnibus spending bill provides funding for the wrong cities. How are so many Americans so ignorant of the actual crisis at the border? The answer is simple. Most news organizations rarely cover the border crisis. Would more Americans favor different policies if they understood what was happening at the border? After the pollsters gave them the accurate information, two-thirds (67%) then said they would favor “newer, stricter policies to reduce the flow of people coming across the border.” This might also explain why in the omnibus spending bill, much of the funding will apparently go to places like New York City to reimburse them for services provided to the 30,000 migrants that ended up there. By contrast, the mayor of El Paso, Texas declared an emergency after 80,000 migrants were released into the region. When the establishment media fails to cover the border crisis, the American people are ignorant of the problem and politicians often allocate funds in the wrong way.

2. ISSUE/TOPIC: Hiding God’s Word in your Heart

PROGRAM: Revive our Hearts, January 10, 2023; 9:00-9:30am

DESCRIPTION: Listeners joined host Nancy Wolgemuth as she talked with Glenna Marshall about scripture memorization. They discussed how the more you dwell on scripture the less attached you will be to the things of this world. Glenna shared why memorizing God’s Word matters. She spoke not only to inspire you to learn God’s Word but also to equip us with ways to do that.

3. ISSUE/TOPIC: Understanding Autism

PROGRAM: Joni and Friends, March 31, 2023; 8:00-8:05 am

DESCRIPTION: On today’s program, as part of Autism Awareness Month, Joni interviews her friend Zach about his experience with autism.

4. ISSUE/TOPIC: Dealing with Depression

PROGRAM: Love Worth Finding, January 2, 2023; 8:00-8:30pm

DESCRIPTION: Are you down, feeling hopeless, or battling depression? Pastor Adrian Rogers encourages listeners to look inward, upward, and onward. There is hope, and it begins with trusting Jesus, even when things don't make sense. Choose to praise Him, even when it hurts.

5. ISSUE/TOPIC: Marriage

PROGRAM: Grace to You, February 9, 2023, 7:30-8:00pm

DESCRIPTION: Pastor John MacArthur continues his compelling look at the biblical Guidelines for Singleness and Marriage. He focuses on a lesson to help you understand how your marriage, even if you're married to an unbeliever, can honor God and help lead others to salvation.

6. ISSUE/TOPIC: Worldview - Atheism

PROGRAM: Answers in Genesis, January 11, 2023; 3:28pm

DESCRIPTION: Host Ken Ham shares how atheism is being taught to millions of children in America's public schools. But how's this happening? Well, by and large they teach children that life and the universe arose by evolution over millions of years. So, the conclusion is—whether it's stated outright or not—there's no Creator God. Students are also largely taught morality is relative and there are no absolutes. Right and wrong depend on the individual. Again, this view only makes sense if there's no God. It's a worldview devoid of God and his Word that's being passed along. And parents need to know this and be more diligent about teaching their children the right way to think!

7. ISSUE/TOPIC: Recession Protection

PROGRAM: My Money Life, March 31, 2023; 11:30am

DESCRIPTION: A recession is coming... We know it's coming because it's a normal part of the economic cycle. We just don't know when. That's why it's important to prepare while you can. Don't procrastinate or assume that you'll just be okay. Those who wait often panic and make impulsive decisions. God is the Rock on which your financial strength must stand. Host Chuck Bentley encouraged listeners to get their financial house in order before a storm comes. Pay down credit card debt and refuse to assume any more that you can't pay off every month. Reduce all possible expenses. Drop any unnecessary spending and adjust your lifestyle so you can lower your overhead. This will enable you to build emergency savings and prevent borrowing. Avoid home equity loans, except when absolutely necessary. Same goes for borrowing against your 401(k) or 403(b). Run from risky investments and choose to be optimistic. For, "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble." (Psalm 46:1)

8. ISSUE/TOPIC: Abuse

PROGRAM: Unshackled, January 7, 2023; 4:00-4:30pm

DESCRIPTION: Raised by a cruel and angry mother, Amy Trees grew up feeling alone and unworthy. Could she find a way to be free of the humiliation she suffered and find the kind of friend she longed for? Listeners were encouraged as they heard this true testimony of finding worth and healing in Christ on this episode of Unshackled.

9. ISSUE/TOPIC: Doubting our Faith

PROGRAM: Adventures in Odyssey, February 11, 2023, 7:30-8:00am

DESCRIPTION: Olivia Parker has been struggling for weeks with her faith. After the accidental death of a beloved school teacher, Olivia begins to doubt if God cares and if He is even real. Through her parents, friends, trusted mentors in the fictional town of Odyssey, Olivia is brought to the end of her doubt and learns that God is real and He cares. She also learns that

you have to take every thought captive and trusting God even when it doesn't make sense is part of what faith is all about.

10. **ISSUE/TOPIC: Human Trafficking**

PROGRAM: Revive our Hearts, January 11, 2023; 9:00-9:30am

DESCRIPTION: Guests Al & Susan share with host Nancy Wolgemuth about their ministry to abused and at risk children in Asia. "I may never be able to reach the millions or even hundreds of thousands of at-risk children. But together we can make a difference in one, in two, then in a third one. Over a period of years as they become Disciples of Christ this multiplies. And this way we can reach many" says Al. Nancy interviewed Al & Susan about their important work on this broadcast.

11. **ISSUE/TOPIC: Intelligence Gathering**

PROGRAM: Viewpoints Commentary, March 10, 2023, 11:15am

DESCRIPTION: We have been talking about China. When talking about China, we usually talk about its strengths and technological developments. But there is another side too: intelligence gathering. And there is a lesson to be learned here. Sometimes the important information is out there but never collected because it doesn't seem relevant to the intelligence gathering mindset the president or the bureaucracy might have. Intelligence work is like science. You don't collect random information and hope that something will pop up. You need an informed view of the world and know what you want to accomplish.
