NOTICE: Due to software conversions at PBS and report size, we will now post one report per year to cover the required 2-year time period. Older reports will not be updated, but will remain available for your use. All are available in text and excel versions.

For Programs airing after 7/1/2009, please see the report titled "PBS 2 Yr Funding Report -- Updated" This new report will be updated in the same manner as the previous report. It will be posted regularly and will include programs going forward at least one week. The current posted report has data for programs through 3/31/2010.

For Programs airing between 7/1/2008 and 8/31/2009, please see the report titled "PBS_Funding_Report_2008_7_1 to 2009_8_31" This report will not be updated.

For programs that air from April 1, 2006 through 7/1/2008, please use the report called "PBS 2 YR Funding Report -- Current Report". This report also will not be updated.

The report listed as "PBS 2 YR Funding Report" covers programs up to April 1, 2006, and will not be updated.

The PBS Underwriting Report lists the names of underwriters of PBS programs with either original broadcast dates or current broadcast rights within the past two years. It is generated weekly and includes programs scheduled to be fed over the satellite interconnection within one week or more of the report date.

The underwriters listed in the report are those that have been provided to us by program presenters as of the report generation date. If you have questions about individual programs or series, we recommend that you refer to the original program offers distributed via PBS Express and PBS Connect.

This report is provided as a resource to help stations fulfill their FCC obligation to maintain a daily updated donor list in their public inspection files. It is meant to supplement the station's own broadcast record, which also may include locally produced programs or programs acquired from other distributors.

Finally, some PBS programs and series have such extensive lists of donors that they have not been entered individually in our source database. In those cases, when you see the words "various" or "additional" funders, you can access the remaining funders electronically from the Program Underwriting Policy resource page at the list page containing public inspection file donor lists.
