He hoped that Trump could be discharged from the hospital and return to the White House as soon as Monday. Conley said that Trump's blood oxygen level dropped twice during his treatment. When his blood oxygen level was lower than 94% when he had a high fever last Friday, he needed to receive oxygen. About an hour later, he no longer needs oxygen. The current blood oxygen level maintains 98%.
