U.S. will not send any diplomats or official representatives to participate, but athletes can still participate in the competitions. Cause of this action is that "China continues to commit genocide and crimes against humanity in Xinjiang," said the White House Press Secretary Jen Psaki. Chinese government has consistently denied the allegations. Foreign Ministry spokesperson Zhao Lijian said in response to a question on diplomatic boycott on Monday that "If the US insists on going its own way, China will definitely take countermeasure resolutions."
