However, the plan to gradually replace the old plate with the new design plate was immediately come under fire. In addition, the state announced that the old license plate that are in use for more than ten years must be renewed, and the owner must pay \$25 for the new design plate, plus an additional \$20 for keeping one's original license plate number.
