On July 9<sup>th</sup>, U.S. White House National Security Advisor Sullivan said that President Biden believed that Yellen had a very important and substantive interaction, which was important for maintaining open communication channels between the United States and China. It is important to clearly communicate the U.S. intentions, priorities, and concerns about certain Chinese behaviors. US media broadcast an exclusive interview with Yellen on the day she returned to U.S. She said that her visit to China was a success. Sullivan said that Biden received written updates from Yellen every day during her visit to China. Her team also briefed the national security team and which was conveyed to Biden. She will submit a complete report to Biden later on. Regarding whether the U.S.-China interaction will return to setting up "guardrails," Sullivan only said that the two countries are in fierce competition and must be managed responsibly, relying on the intensive diplomacy of Secretary of State Blinken, Yellen and other officials. He also mentioned that China still resists maintaining military ties with the United States and the military hotline has not been restored, calling on China to take action to carry out military dialogue.

Video from the scene showed that the high-altitude operating platform of the crane involved burst into flames and emitted thick smoke, and its boom hit a nearby building during the fall.

A "fat robot" weighing 420 pounds, 5 feet 2 inches tall, and with a camera on its head will start working the night shift at New York's Times Square subway station on the 22nd. If the twomonth trial period is successfully passed, it will replace some police officers alone. Patrol subway stations across the city. Mayor Eric Adams and the City Police Department launched the Knightscope K5 Autonomous Security Robot, introducing it as an advanced "new force to detect criminals". It is equipped with multiple cameras all over the body and can communicate with the police in real time video communication to better convey real-time information about subway events. The K5 robot is almost as tall as Adams, but has a waist width at least three times that of the mayor. It has a 360-degree "no blind spots" surveillance field of view and a maximum moving speed of 3 miles per hour. Although it has a number of smart technologies, the City Police Department stated that the K5 robot will only use video surveillance methods currently allowed in New York City and will not enable facial recognition and audio technologies.
