The Justice Department of Canada said that Meng Wanzhou, the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) of Huawei, was arrested in Vancouver and may be extradited to the United States. Meng Wanzhou is also the Vice Chairman of Huawei and the daughter of Huawei founder Ren Zhengfei. A spokesperson for the Canadian Department of Justice said she was arrested on December 1 and the court hearing is scheduled to take place on Friday, December 6. In the statement, Huawei confirmed the news that Meng Wanzhou was arrested, and said that there is very little information about the specific allegations provided to Huawei, and Huawei "does not know that Ms. Meng has any misconduct."
