Jan 5/6 :30 minute show with Guardians of the Children. President Ernie Cuaron and International Ambassador Frank Montano. Guardians is a group that helps children who have been abused go through the court process, both before and after. They offer reassurance to the child that nothing bad will happen to them and they can testify without fear.

Jan 12/13: :30 minute show with the Albuquerque Hearing, Language and speech center. We talked about the needs of those dealing with hearing loss and the services available them. The Center is a non-profit that can provide hearing aides to those who may not be able to otherwise afford them.

Jan. 19/20 :30 minute show with Connie Vigil and Jimmy Tran with the Greater Albuquerque Business Alliance. The alliance has developed a plan to address homelessness in the Albuquerque Community.

Feb 16/17 :30 minute show with Fred Friedman, with the Historical Society of New Mexico. Fred was able to discuss the history of the railroad industry in the state, from its beginning through today.

Feb 23/24 Bowdich and Dr. Nancy Guinn with Presbyterian Healthcare Foundation on the Dafodil days. This is a fundraiser for the foundation that helps with its Hospice care programs.
