13. Implementing environmentally sound strategies in everyday life.
14. Women's rights and equality in society and the workplace.
15. Native American rights and other issues of interest to the Native American Community.
16. Understanding and tolerance of non-religious ideology and beliefs.
17. Issues surrounding Texas Government and Political Climate
18. Cultural biases based on political, philosophical, or religious beliefs.
19. News and information specific to issues and interests to those who live in the state of Texas.
