



THE PROBLEM IS BIGGER THAN MANY WOULD THINK. THOUSANDS OF ADULTS ARE ILLITERATE. AND THE PROBLEM CAN BE CYCLICAL. THE CHILDREN OF PARENTS WHO EITHER DON'T READ OR CAN'T READ OFTEN PASS THOSE TENDENCIES TO THEIR KIDS. WHEN THE HABIT OF READING IS NOT PROMOTED...THE CHILDREN OF THOSE PARENTS DON'T VALUE THE SKILL.

THE TRIDENT LITERACY ASSOCIATION CONTINUES TO PROMOTE A PROGRAM THAT HELPS FUNCTIONALLY ILLITERATE PARENTS AND THEIR KIDS LEARN TO READ TOGETHER.

THE PROGRAM PROMOTES A BOND AS WELL....AND PARENTS AND THEIR KIDS LEARN READING SKILLS TOGETHER.

THESE ARE STUDENTS WHO HAVE DISABILITIES RANGING FROM BLINDNESS TO PHYSICAL DISABILITIES...HEARING IMPAIRMENTS AND MORE.

THE FOUNDATION PROVIDES EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES THRU THE COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON. KEINZLE SAYS THE C-OF-C COMMUNITY IS QUITE ACCEPTING OF THESE STUDENTS. THAT HELPS ALL STUDENTS TO BE ENRICHED.

KIWANIS CLUBS ARE AS AMERICAN AS CHEVYS AND APPLE PIE. IT IS A COMMUNITY GROUP WORKING TO HELP MAKE CITIES AND TOWNS ACROSS THE UNITED STATES BETTER.

THE AIM IS STILL THE SAME. THE KIWANIS CLUBS STILL WORK IN COMMUNITIES COAST TO COAST HERE. BUT NOW....IT IS EXPANDING TO OVERSEAS CONCERNS. THERE ARE NOW KIWANIS CLUBS ALL OVER THE WORLD.

THE LATEST EFFORT IS IODINE DEFICIENCIES AND TETNUS AROUND THE WORLD.

THE GUESTS SAY THERE ARE TOO MANY DEATHS THRU OUT AFRICA DUE TO THE LACK OF TETNUS SHOT PROTECTION. KIDS AND ADULTS DUE....SIMPLY IF THEY STEP ON SOMETHING SHARP. INFECTION SETS IN....AND DEATH COULD BE THE END RESULT.

MENTORS ARE PEOPLE WHO GIVE FROM A HOUR A WEEK OR MORE TO HELPING YOUNG PEOPLE STAY ON A GOOD PATH AND MAKE SOMETHING OF THEIR LIVES.

THOSE IN NEED OF MENTORS ARE KIDS WHO ARE USUALLY LIVING AROUND THE POVERTY LINE....FROM SINGLE PARENT HOMES....AND ARE CONSIDERED AT-RISK.

THESE KIDS ARE SUSCEPTIBLE TO BAD INFLUENCES SUCH AS GANGS AND DRUGS. A MENTOR CAN BE SOMEONE THE CHILD "ANSWERS TO" IN A WAY. THE MENTOR SHOWS HE OR SHE CARES ABOUT WHAT THE KIDS DOES....AND MOST TIMES THE KID WORKS TO "PLEASE" THE MENTOR. THE MENTOR CAN PROMOTE THE IMPORTANCE OF HOMEWORK IN THE WAY A PARENT MIGHT NOT BE ABLE TO. THE MENTOR WORKS TO HELP THE KID REALIZE WHAT'S IMPORTANT.

MENTORING PROGRAMS HAVE PROVEN TO BE VERY SUCCESSFUL. THE PROBLEM IS THERE ARE MORE KIDS THAN THERE ARE MENTORS.

THE BE-A-MENTOR PROGRAM WORKS EVERYDAY TO PROMOTE MENTORING AND RECRUITING MENTORS

**NULIFE...GIVING HOMELESS VETERANS THE APPRECIATION
THEY DESERVE**

GUESTS: ALLEINE MOSELEY IS PRESIDENT AND CEO OF NULIFE TRANSITIONAL RECOVERY HOUSE IN SUMMERSVILLE....RHONDA DAVIS IS THE FUNDRAISING DIRECTOR FOR NULIFE

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THESE NEW EFFORT TO HELP HOMELESS VETERANS.

MOSELEY IS DEDICATED TO THE VETERANS. SHE IS FROM A MILITARY FAMILY AND HAS THE UTMOST RESPECT FOR THEIR SACRIFICE.

TOO MANY VETS COME HOME AND ARE "LOST". NO JOBS...MANY HAVE A SUBSTANCE ABUSE PROBLEM...AND THEY CAN'T SEEM TO GET ON THEIR FEET IN THE CIVILIAN WORLD.

NULIFE IS AN ATTEMPT TO HELP THESE VETS WITH A TEMPORARY HOME WHILE THEY GET THEIR LIVES TOGETHER. MOSELEY SAYS SHE IS GETTING A LOT OF HELP FROM THE LOCAL MILITARY AND VETERANS GROUPS IN THE LOW COUNTRY. BUT THERE IS MUCH TO DO.

NULIFE IS A 9 ROOM "HOME" IN SUMMERSVILLE. IT IS BEING SET UP TO HOUSE VETERANS. NULIFE ALSO CONNECTS VETS WITH EDUCATION OPTIONS...V-A BENEFITS....AND OTHER THINGS THE VETS NEED AS THEY SETTLE IN BACK HOME.

FUNDRAISERS ARE PLANNED....ALONG WITH MORE AWARENESS OF THE VET PROBLEM IN THE LOW COUNTRY.

GIVING A CHILD A CHANCE THRU ADOPTION

AIR DATE: NOVEMBER 18, 2012

GUEST: DENICE FISHER...EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF A CHOSEN CHILD ADOPTION SERVICES IN SUMMERSVILLE

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE FACTS SURROUNDING ADOPTION AND THE NEED.

LOTS OF AMERICANS AND FOLKS IN THE LOW COUNTRY HAVE BEEN LOOKING OVERSEAS FOR CHILDREN TO ADOPT. MANY TIMES THERE ARE NOT ENOUGH KIDS TO ADOPT HERE IN THE UNITED STATES.

ACTUALLY...FOSTER CARE KIDS ARE IN HIGH NUMBERS. BUT MANY FAMILIES WANT TO ADOPT BABIES...NOT OLDER KIDS.

FISHER SAYS SHE TRIES TO GET YOUNG WOMEN TO INSTEAD OF ABORTION...DO ADOPTION. HER ORGANIZATION SAYS THE ORGANIZATION GOES THRU GREAT PAINS TO FIND GOOD PARENTS FOR THESE BABIES.

THERE ARE ALSO MANY LEGAL ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH ADOPTIONS.....OPEN AND CLOSED ADOPTIONS.....PARENTAL SURRENDER RIGHTS....ETC.

IT CAN BE DIFFICULT TO GET A YOUNG WOMAN TO CARRY A BABY TO TERM...TO HAND THE CHILD OVER TO ADOPTIVE PARENTS. BUT YOUNG WOMEN WHO DO....ACCORDING TO FISHER.....FIND IT TO BE VERY REWARDING. THE BABY GETS A NEW FAMILY THAT CAN PROVIDE...AND THE YOUNG MOTHER CAN (IF SHE WANTS) CAN EVEN GROW UP KNOWING HER CHILD.

IS THERE A WRITER IN YOU? DISCOVERING YOUR CREATIVE SIDE

AIR DATE: NOVEMBER 25, 2012

GUEST: LAURA FOGERTY....CHILD WELFARE ADVOCATE AND AN AUTHOR OF CHILDREN'S BOOKS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE CREATIVE PROCESS THAT....WHEN UNLEASHED...CAN PUT YOU ON A NEW MORE CREATIVE PATH.

LAURA FOGERTY HAS BEEN A GUEST ON CAROLINA PERSPECTIVE DURING THE PROGRAMS DEALING WITH CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE .

BUT SHE HAS ALSO WRITTEN BOOKS FOR KIDS ON THE SUBJECT OF SUCH ABUSE.....BOOKS KIDS CAN UNDERSTAND. HER FIRST ONE WAS "I'M THE BOSS OF ME".

THE AUDIENCE FOR THE BOOK IS KIDS....AND THEIR PARENTS. BUT KIDS CAN BE AMONG THE TOUGHEST AUDIENCES. LUCKILY FOR HER....THE BOOK WAS DEEMED VERY GOOD.

IF YOU THINK THERE IS A BOOK IN YOU....THE LOWCOUNTRY HAS QUITE A FEW OUTLETS FOR YOU TO LEARN AND BRING OUT YOUR WRITING SKILLS.

THERE ARE A NUMBER OF LITERARY GROUPS THAT MEET WEEKLY OR MONTHLY HERE. THERE ARE ALSO POETRY NIGHTS THRU OUT THE LOW COUNTRY WHERE A BUDDING WRITER CAN "TRYOUT THEIR STUFF" INFRONT OF A LIVE AUDIENCE.

START WRITING DAILY IN A JOURNAL...AND TAKE IT FROMTHERE. FOGERTY IS SURE THAT MOST CAN GET A REAL FEELING OF SATISFACTION OF WRITING....WHETHER FOR ONE'S SELF OR FOR PROFIT

MEALS ON WHEELS ROLLS ON EAST OF THE COOPER

AIR DATE: DECEMBER 2, 2012

GUESTS: SARAH VEGA...STAFF MEMBER WITH EAST COOPER MEALS ON WHEELS.....AND BOB AND LINDA JOHNSON...TWO KEY VOLUNTEERS WITH MEALS ON WHEELS

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE WORK OF THE EAST COOPER MEALS ON WHEELS ORGANIZATION.

SOUTH CAROLINA RANKS 8TH IN THE NATION WHEN IT COMES TO THE NUMBERS OF SENIORS AT RISK FOR HUNGER. EAST COOPER MEALS ON WHEELS WILL HAVE DELIVERED 147-THOUSAND MEALS BY THE END OF 2012.

MEALS ON WHEELS PROVIDES TWO MEALS A DAY TO THE ELDERLY. THESE ARE RESIDENTS WHO ARE TOO OLD AND FRAIL TO COOK FOR THEMSELVES. SOME CLIENTS ARE YOUNGER AND DISABLED AND NOT ABLE TO GET TO A STORE TO SHOP.

THESE ARE RESIDENTS WHO WERE WHOLE AND HEALTHY AT ONE TIME. BUT IN THE PROGRESSION OF AGE....ALONG WITH DECLINING HEALTH AND OTHER THINGS....MAKES THEM CANDIDATES FOR THE FOOD DELIVERY SERVICE.

THE JOHNSON'S ARE RETIRED AND HAVE THE TIME TO WORK AT MEALS ON WHEELS. THEY SAY THEY'VE MADE FRIENDS WITH MANY OF THE CLIENTS....AND FEEL FOR THEM A GREAT DEAL. THEY TRY AND SPEND AT LEAST A FEW MINUTES ASKING THE CLIENTS ABOUT THEIR HEALTH...AND IF THEY NEED ANYTHING. SOMETIMES THE JOHNSONS ARE THE ONLY CONTACT THESE CLIENTS HAVE DURING THE DAY. MEALS ON WHEELS SERVES A LOT OF NEEDS OF OUR OLDER RESIDENTS.

DISCUSSION CENTERED ON THE ASSOCIATIONS QUEST TO FIND FAMILIES TO PARTICIPATE IN A NEW AN INNOVATIVE READING PROGRAM.

LEARNING TO READ IS PRIMARY TO LEARNING....EDUCATION....HELPS KEEP ONE FROM SLIDING INTO POVERTY.

THERE ARE OTHER DECISIONS THATKEEP ONE FROM A LIFE OF POVERTY....BUT READING AND EDUCATION ARE PARAMOUNT.
