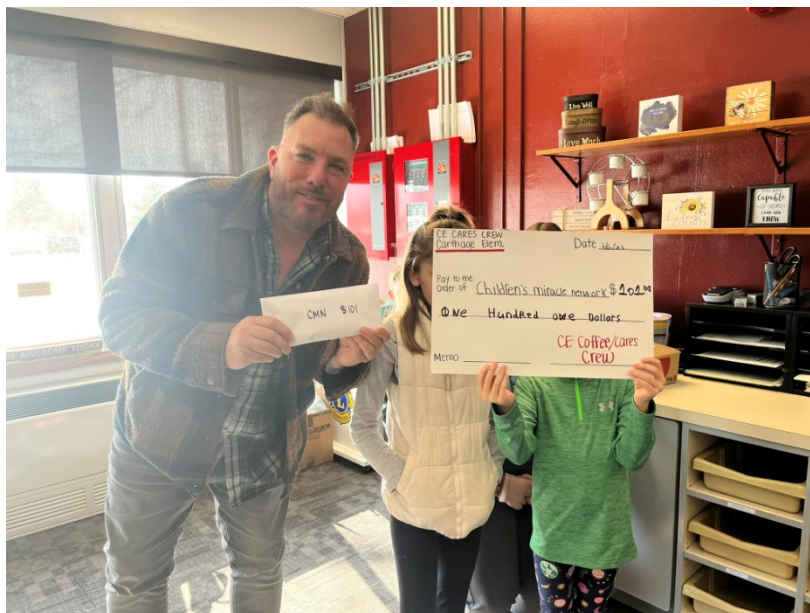

Honor a Veteran 2023

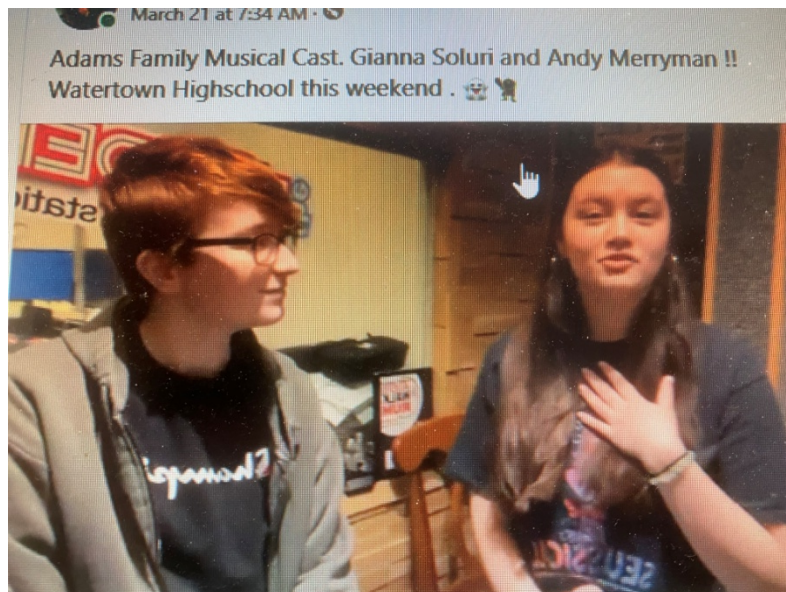
