- 4. The following are the long-term menu options implemented between January 22, 2012-January 21, 2013 including a brief description of each:
- A. <u>GENERAL EMPLOYMENT OUTREACH/JOB BANKS:</u> The Station's general employment outreach is done on an on-going basis. When positions become available, the Station widely disseminates information about Station job openings through online job banks, printed media and continual communication with the local, state and other colleges. The primary sources for hiring include industry websites and job banks such as http://www.tvjobs.com and http://medialine.com. Both tvjobs.com and medialine.com are nationwide, broadcast industry-specific websites that attract a broad range of applicants. The Station also routinely posts open positions on general websites and job banks.
- B. <u>TOURS:</u> KNOP-TV provides tours to students of all ages as well as to local high school students. The Station tours are designed to provide students with a first-hand look at the on-air broadcast industry and to encourage awareness of broadcast job opportunities both in the industry and at KNOP-TV.
- C. <u>JOB FAIRS</u>: The Station participated in local job fairs at the Mayor's Youth Leadership Academy, Expanding Your Horizons Math & Sciences Seminar, Maggie Burke job shadowing, Lincoln Elementary School, Sutherland Elementary School and St. Pat's Jr. High School. The purpose of the job fairs is to raise awareness of employment in the on-air broadcast field and to specifically advertise for potential position with the Station.
- D. <u>COLLEGIATE BROADCAST PARTICIPATION</u>: The Station maintains ongoing contact with professors at the University of Nebraska at Lincoln, the University of Nebraska at Kearney, the University of Nebraska at Omaha, and Mid Plains Community College, regarding recruitment opportunities for their institutions' students.

- E. <u>KNOP-TV/NBA SCHOLARSHIP: One</u> \$1400 scholarships was awarded to a qualified student who is currently attending a Nebraska public or private university or college and majoring in broadcasting, communications or related field.
