	TYPE OF RECRUITMENT INITIATIVE (MENU SELECTION)	BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY
1	Participate in Job Fair	On September 8, 2008, our stations participated in a career fair at the University of Missouri-Columbia. Station participants included our Promotions Director and Operations Manager, who collected resumes and discussed job opportunities at the stations with students interested in broadcasting careers.
2	Internship Program	During the reporting period, our stations hosted 14 interns from the University of Missouri. The internship program is designed to give college students exposure to the radio and promotions industry and offers meaningful educational and work experiences to meet the academic and career goals of the intern. Interns typically will assist radio personalities as well as the Promotions Director in attending and setup up for all radio and promotional events. In addition, they will assist all other departments with any special projects or assistance needed. The interns typically report directly to the Promotions Director.
3	Host Event/Program for an Educational Institution Relating to Career Opportunities in Broadcasting	<p>During the reporting period, our stations provided station tours to the groups listed below. Station participants included our Operations Manager and two On-Air Announcers, who conducted the tour and provided information to the students about radio operations and broadcasting careers.</p> <p>(1) In April 2008, our stations provided a station tour to a group of students who participate in "The Intersection," a local program serving at-risk kids in Columbia, MO.</p> <p>(2) On April 3, 2008, our stations provided a station tour to a group of students from Columbia Catholic School. As part of the tour, station participants discussed the production and scripting of radio commercials, and the</p>

		<p>teachers assigned the class the project of writing their own advertisement, three of which were selected to be produced and aired on KPLA(FM) on April 23, 2008.</p> <p>(3) In March 2008, our stations conducted two separate station tours for local Cub Scout troops, who were able to earn a communications merit badge.</p> <p>(4) On February 6, 2008, our stations provided a station tour to a group of students from Columbia Catholic School as part of our Partners-In-Education outreach program.</p> <p>(5) In January 2008, our stations conducted two separate station tours for local Cub Scout troops, who were able to earn a communications merit badge.</p> <p>(6) On January 15, 2008 and January 17, 2008, our stations provided three separate station tours to a group of students from Columbia Catholic School as part of our Partners-In-Education outreach program.</p>

Station participants included our Market Manager, who showed the class the various aspects of a radio station, including an on-air studio, production studio, and our sales department, and provided students with information about broadcasting careers.</p>
