

WBSU-FM ISSUES-PROGRAMS LIST

Although the FCC no longer prescribes formal ascertainment procedures, WBSU-FM sponsored a comprehensive ascertainment of the general public and community leaders in the communities of Albion, Brockport, Clarkson, Hamlin, Hilton, Holley, Kendall, Spencerport and Sweden. The survey was conducted from 1/98 – 5/98.

174 members of the community were interviewed and 424 responses were recorded. Although we find no substantial differences from previous surveys in public perception of community problems, we have amended our “Problems” list to seven (7) subjects, which were prominently discovered:

1. Traffic/Roads
2. Crime/Vandalism
3. Youth Problems/Recreation
4. Taxes/Economy
5. Drugs
6. Landlords/Rental Properties
7. Environmental Issues
