

The announcements (there are a minimum of six of them) should be broadcast on the appropriate dates as follows:

- At least three of the required announcements between 7 AM to 9 AM and/or 4 PM to 6 PM
- At least one announcement between 9 AM to Noon.
- At least one announcement between Noon to 4 PM.
- At least one announcement between 7 PM to Midnight.
- If the station doesn't operate between 7 AM to 9 AM or 4 PM to 6 PM, then at least three of the required announcements during the first two hours of operation.

Once the announcements have been broadcast, fill out an affidavit that recites the dates and times the post-filing announcements were broadcast over the air. The affidavit should look something like this:

## WRVL POST-FILING ANNOUNCEMENT

On October 8, 2003 WRVL was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until October 1, 2011. Our license will expire on October 1, 2011.
