Livingston County State's Attorney successfully argued a case that had significant repercussions for state's attorneys and crime victims. A Freedom of Information Act Request was submitted in Livingston County asking for evidence and other information regarding a grisly Livingston County murder. Uphoff refused, saying that the judiciary was exempt from FOIA requirements. The person seeking the information argued that state's attorneys are elected officials, and therefore not technically part of the judiciary. Uphoff explained the ramifications of the ruling delivered by the Appellate Court.
