Dear General Manager:

As you know, Broadcast Music, Inc.'s ("BMI") most recent license agreement with your radio station and other stations in the radio industry (the "BMI-10 License") expired on December 31, 2016. After a period of dispute, BMI and the Radio Music License Committee ("RMLC") recently reached an agreement on interim license fees to be paid by all radio stations that have authorized the RMLC to act on their behalf in connection with negotiations and/or proceedings to establish BMI license fees and terms for the period effective January 1, 2017 ("RMLC Stations"). We enclose a copy of the Interim Fee Order confirming that agreement, signed by Judge Louis L. Stanton on February 24, 2017 in *Broadcast Music, Inc. v. Radio Music License Committee, Inc.* Under the Interim Fee Order, as an RMLC Station, your station is obligated to pay license fees based on the same rates and terms set forth in the BMI-10 License including the blanket license rate of 1.7% of revenue (subject to the deductions set forth in the BMI-10 License). The interim fee will be retroactively adjusted based on whatever final fees and terms are established by negotiations between BMI and the RMLC, or by order of the BMI Rate Court.

BMI suspended current fee billing to RMLC Stations effective January 1, 2017. Because interim rates have now been established, BMI will begin billing your station(s) retroactively for periods beginning January 1, 2017. This does not impact any outstanding balance on your account for the period prior to January 1, 2017 nor prejudice any pending or potential action by BMI seeking any such prior amounts owed.

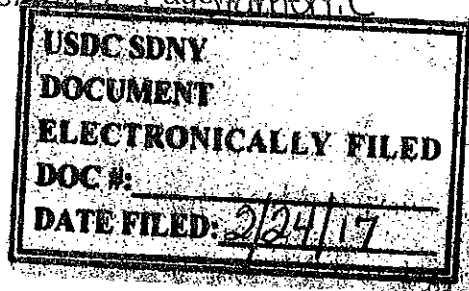

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section XIV(B) of its Consent Decree,<sup>1</sup> Petitioner Broadcast Music, Inc. ("BMI") applied to this Court for a determination of reasonable interim license fees effective January 1, 2017 until such time as final fees and terms are established by negotiations or determination by this Court ("2017 Interim Fees"); and

WHEREAS, Respondent Radio Music License Committee (the "RMLC"), in its capacity as representative of the FCC-licensed broadcast radio stations (and group owners thereof) operating in the United States which have authorized the RMLC to act on their behalf in connection with negotiations and/or proceedings to establish BMI license fees and terms for the period effective January 1, 2017-forward (the "RMLC Stations"), a current list of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, has subsequently agreed with BMI that 2017 Interim Fees should be based on the rates set forth in the last final BMI – radio industry (individual station or group) license which expired on December 31, 2016 (known as the "BMI-10 License," as defined below); and

WHEREAS, BMI and the RMLC (together, the "Parties") have consented to the entry of this Order to carry out the agreement they have reached, with the mutual understanding and acknowledgement that (i) such 2017 Interim Fees are entirely without prejudice to each Party's positions regarding what constitutes reasonable final fees and terms for a BMI – radio station license for the period effective January 1, 2017-forward, and (ii) such 2017 Interim Fees shall be retroactively adjusted based on whatever final fees and terms are established by negotiations or determination of this Court; it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED:

1. For the period commencing January 1, 2017, the fees and terms set forth in the BMI-10 Radio Station Blanket/Per Program License Agreement and its annexed exhibits (the "BMI-10 License"), attached hereto as Exhibit B, including the blanket license rate of 1.7% of revenue (subject to the deductions set forth in the BMI-10 License), shall continue in force on an interim basis pending a negotiated agreement of the Parties or subsequent determination by the Court of reasonable final fees for the period commencing January 1, 2017.

2. In connection with this proceeding and the administration of the BMI-10 License, the RMLC represents the approximately 7,800 domestic commercial broadcast radio stations listed on Exhibit A. BMI and the RMLC may, by agreement, amend or supplement the list attached as Exhibit A. Each owner of an RMLC Station shall be deemed licensed and bound by the terms of this Order and the terms and conditions of the BMI-10 License, on an interim license basis effective January 1, 2017 and subject to retroactive adjustment as set forth above.

3. BMI shall mail a copy of this Order to each RMLC Station no later than March 15, 2017.

4. Entry of this Order is without prejudice to any arguments or positions BMI or the RMLC may assert in any further final fee proceeding to determine: (i) what constitutes reasonable blanket license, per-program license, or adjustable-fee blanket license fees for domestic commercial broadcast radio stations; (ii) terms for such licenses; (iii) the appropriate scope of such licenses; (iv) the methodology for calculating fees for such licenses; and/or (v) the reasonableness of the structure of such licenses or license fees.

5. This Order shall not be considered or construed to constitute a determination by the Court of what constitutes a reasonable final license fee.

6. The Court retains continuing jurisdiction over this proceeding for the purpose of enforcing this Order and the terms, conditions, and obligations of the BMI-10 License, as extended on an interim license basis by this Order.
