Issue covered: House of Hope

Program: Bill and Rookie did sports trivia with WealthPlan after their segment. Bill and Rookie earned money to be donated to House of Hope for each correct answer. Bill and Rookie earned \$400 and Mike from WealthPlan matched up to \$500 in donations from Fan Nation
