Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WRKH provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Criminial Justice System: Mobile County District Attorney Ashley Rich talks about the challenges of getting those who are arrested through the criminal justice system in a timely manner, with budget cuts in the court system. She also talked about issues with the board of pardons and paroles letting criminals out too soon.
- Drugs: The National Prescription Drug Take Back Day addresses a crucial public safety and public health issue. According to the 2017 National Survey on Drug Use and Health, 6 million Americans misused controlled prescription drugs. The study shows that a majority of abused prescription drugs were obtained from family and friends, often from the home medicine cabinet. The DEA's Take Back Day events provide an opportunity for Americans to prevent drug addiction and overdose deaths. Hosted by Bernie Lucas, iHeartMedia, with Guest Uttam Dhillon, Acting Administrator DEA
- Education: Dr John Valentine, director of the Dauphin Island Sealab and Helene Hussell, director of the SeaLab foundation, talk about the mission of the Dauphin Island Sea Lab, to pursue excellence in marine science education, research, coastal zone management policy and public engagement. The program also included information on a public fundraiser for the Sea Lab.
- Education/Housing: Jessica Wofford and Freddie Stokes with Fuse Project talk about Dragon Boat Races on June 8th at the Battleship, which raise money to help local children. Fuse Project has identified a neighborhood in Mobile to begin the Purpose Built Community Project. Freddie Stokes talked about meeting with members of that community to get them on board with plans to work together with Fuse Project and local agencies to provide housing, wellness and education within that community, to give residents opportunity. iHeartRadio Mobile/Pensacola was a media sponsor of Dragon Boat and competed in the races. The event was promoted through recorded PSAs, live liners, social media and website community calendar.
- Healthcare: iHeart sponsored the inaugural Sista Strut Breast Cancer Walk in Mobile,

highlighting the impact of breast cancer in African American women and seeking to educate them on early detection and community resources. Proceeds benefit the Anchor Cross Cancer Foundation and Franklin Primary Health.

- Hunger: Feeding the Gulf Coast, formerly the Mobile Bay Area Foodbank, is gearing up for summer feeding programs, to make sure that students who usually get free meals during the school year have hot meals available during the summer. Also talked about the Backpack program, sending meals home for the weekend during the school year, for students who may not have sufficient food at home. Talked about ways to volunteer and ways to donate to Feeding the Gulf Coast
- Public Safety: Mobile Public Safety Director James Barber talks about gun crime in Mobile and measures homeowners can take to protect themselves, including locking their cars. Barber says organized rings of gun traffickers are going through neighborhoods looking for guns in unlocked cars, but a PSA effort to get owners to lock vehicles has reduced gun thefts 40%. Barber talked about how police are working in problem areas of the city, with 2 local programs that have gone national... one focusing on 9th grade youth to keep them in school and out of trouble; the other focusing on nonviolent criminals, giving them a Second Chance to avoid jail and work in the community.
 - Tourism: Visit Mobile is projecting a record summer for convention tourism in Mobile. Tara Zieman talks about recruitment of conventions and sporting events, promoting Mobile as a tourist destination, coordinating efforts with Carnival Cruise line, and enlisting the support of citizens and local tourism businesses (hotels, restaurants, attractions) to promote Mobile.
