Section 1 – List of Issues

- 1. MENTAL HEALTH** - Access to mental health continues to be a problem in many areas of the country. Here in Iowa, many residents are still coping with the mental and emotional impacts of the 2020 derecho.
- 2. CANNABIS** - The federal government is considering lowering the drug classification for cannabis. Meanwhile, while the drug continues to be illegal in Iowa, loopholes are allowing certain products like gummies and infused drinks to be purchased.
- 3. DEBT** - While the federal government stares down another deadline with the debt ceiling and government funding, many Iowa families are facing school lunch debt. Food programs that were free during COVID are now charging families again.
- 4. AI** - While we grapple with the legal and ethical questions involving AI, companies in Iowa including seed corn companies and groups that forecast weather are looking at ways to incorporate the new technology.
- 5. RETIREMENT** - An uncertain economy and inflation are making it harder for people to retire. Here in Iowa, a new study ranked the state as the best place to retire due to a low cost of living, low crime, and access to healthcare.
