Date and Time	Program	Duration	Description
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10/22/2017 08:00a Bill Nye the Science Guy 30 minutes Learn about populations. Host, Bill Nye explores how groupings of people, chickens, lions compete for food, homes, and space.

10/22/2017 08:30a Bill Nye the Science Guy 30 minutes Learn about animal locomotion. Check out the millipede with 200 feet and other animals without a foot to stand on. Music video, "Lomote," drives the point home.

10/29/2017 08:00a Bill Nye the Science Guy 30 minutes Viewers learn about earthquakes and how the earth's surface is broken into plates. They learn how earthquakes occur due to the energy stored in plates are suddenly released. Viewers are taught how the surface of the Earth is changed due to earthquakes.

10/29/2017 08:30a Bill Nye the Science Guy 30 minutes Viewers learn about how "uncool" pollution is to our world. Exploring the damaging effects of pollution to the earth and showing how each of us can do our part to be a part of the solution.

11/19/2017 08:00a Bill Nye the Science Guy 30 minutes Viewers learn about inventions and the careful process it involves, while exploring accidental inventions that have come to be. Special guest Samuel L. Jackson joins host, Bill Nye in the exploration of how our trusted gadgets have come to be.

11/19/2017 08:30a Bill Nye the Science Guy 30 minutes Did you know that humans carry 80,000 genes? Bill Nye explores the importance of genes how they determine eye color to so much more! Explore the chromosomal world of DNA and visit a veterinarian from Seattle Woodland Park Zoo who helps save endangered animals using gene technology.

11/26/2017 08:00a Bill Nye the Science Guy 30 minutes Viewers learn about scientific principles and how to use the same lessons in the world around them. Bill Nye guides the viewer into do-it-yourself experiments with common household items. Bill Nye really brings home the message science is everywhere with the "Do-It-Yourself Science" music video.
