

Quarterly Issues Programs List for KTEM

April 1 to June 30th, 2019

The station has identified the following issues as significant issues facing our community in this quarter.

A. Gas Pump Card Skimmer/Local Theft: Wes Adams interviews Sergeant John David Roberts Texas Highway Patrol. A card skimmer was recently found at a Valero station at a busy intersection in Robinson. This segment shares info with the public about spotting a card skimmer, what to do if you think your information has been stolen, and how to use a smart phone to detect a Bluetooth skimmer at a pump.

B. Service Outage City of Killeen Utility Collections: A scheduled outage is coming to the city's utility collections website this week. Killeen residents will not be able to pay important utility bills, court fees, or permit fees online until the outage is over. Killeen Director of Communications Hilary Shine explains how residents can make payments in person to avoid service disruptions or late fees.

C. Temple Road Construction/Closures: Street closures in downtown Temple will impact morning and afternoon drive in the city for the next several days. This segment provides information on the closings, the duration, and alternate routes through town before during the city's spring festival.

D. Texas Real ID Act: Texan's who do not update their driver's license before the Real ID Act deadline of 10/1/2020 will not be able to board an airplane at a Texas airport or enter some federal buildings. This discussion provides information on how to get updated in time and the which offices to visit.

E. EF-3 Tornado Hits Franklin: An EF-3 Tornado caused severe damage to the community of Franklin, Texas. Shannon Groves with Franklin ISD shared information with our listeners about the storm damage and fundraisers to help repair buildings and the local high school.

F. City Wide Disaster Drill: Killeen, Texas: City personnel will run through a simulation for a citywide response to large-scale emergencies and disasters. In advance of emergencies, the office works to educate the public, connect resources and train personnel. Preparedness can help reduce the impacts of emergency events and speed recovery efforts. Information is shared with our audience on how they can participate and volunteer, along with what to expect the day of the test.

G. Local Flooding and Highway Closures: A flood warning for the Little River caused extreme flooding in downtown Salado and along the I-35 frontage road. This segment reviews road closures from Chisholm Trail to Stagecoach Circle as several cars have been washed off the road in this area.

H. Temple Animal Ordinance: Temple Media Relations Specialist Ellen Morton explains the chance Temple residents to have change what the code of ordinances actually spells out as the law of the land when it comes to pets within the city.

I. Temple Planning Committee: Brian Chandler with Temple Planning Committee shares information on a series of public meetings that ask for the residents of Temple to help provide their input on expansion and city plans. The Planning committee seeks the public's help with plans for developing are public parks, expansion of roadways and road construction projects and help with planning the future of the community. Information is provided on the meeting schedule and how the public and make suggestions and give feedback to the planning committee.

J. Senate Bill 317: This segment provides information on a change in the law that will impact many rural families living on farms and away from urban communities in our listening area. Senate Bill 317, just signed by Governor Abbott, will allow landowners outside city limits to shoot feral hogs trespassing on their property without needing credentials to do so. Texas is home to the largest feral hog population in the country. This segment spotlights the specifics of the bill and which areas of Bell County have been problem areas with the hog population.

K. Infant Swimming Resource: After country singer Granger Smith's 3-year-old son drowned in the pool of their Georgetown, Texas home some of our listeners brought up the importance of teaching kids to swim. Kim Utley talks about ISR classes available in Texas and water safety as the summer swimming months approach.

L. Storm Debris Drop Off: This segment offers information to the public looking to clean up after the EF-2 Tornado and strong thunderstorms that tore up roofs and trees throughout neighborhoods in Copperas Cove over the weekend. Rickie Roy explains the Citizen Collection Center at 201 Brown Street will accept any and all storm debris to help residents clean up after the storms.

M. Killeen Homeless Community Shelter: Killeen's only homeless shelter remains closed after running out of funding earlier in the spring. A tent city has begun to grow outside the shelter as the heavy rains and summer heat begin to build while the city is still trying to figure out a way to re-open the facility. William Hall discusses ways the public can donate funding and basic essentials to those who depend on the shelter for basic necessities.
