Radio Station **KZEP-FM** provides music and news service to the San Antonio area. A variety of program elements, including local traffic and weather reports, public service announcements, and locally produced public affairs programs help us to fulfill our public service commitment to our listeners. Listed below are the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter, followed by a list of programming which addressed these issues.

- **ARTS AND CULTURE:** Need for support for the arts and cultural programs/events.
- **CRIME:** Gangs, violence in schools, domestic violence, road rage, alcohol and drug abuse.
- **ECONOMY:** Employment issues. Lack of good-paying jobs. Growth issues.
- **EDUCATION:** Efforts should be made to provide equal educational opportunities to students in all areas of the city. Need higher educational standards. Pre-K for SA.
- **ENVIRONMENT/WATER ISSUES:** Edwards Aquifer protection; air pollution; growth issues that affect the environment.
- **GOVERNMENT:** Politics. Accountability. Taxes. "Get out the Vote".
- **HEALTH ISSUES:** Especially obesity (San Antonio has been cited as one of America's "fattest cities".) Affordable Healthcare Act.
- **MINORITIES:** Economic development for Hispanics and African-Americans in San Antonio; discrimination by law enforcement.
- **PUBLIC SAFETY:** Drainage problems and flooding; traffic hazards such as too much construction at one time.
- **POVERTY:** Among working poor; homeless people; growth of single parent families; general nutrition and medical needs of poor people.
- **WAR/TERRORISM/SECURITY:** News of the war and its impact on the citizens of San Antonio, the nation, and the world, as well as the threat of terrorism and how to handle it; local emergency planning.
