## Continued Class A Eligibility Statement WBXN-CD 1st Quarter, 2024

Section (f)(2)(a) of the Community Broadcasters Protection Act ("CBPA") and Section 73.6001 of the FCC's rules set forth the continuing eligibility requirements for Class A licensees.

To maintain its eligibility for a Class A license, a Class A station must continue to broadcast at least 18 hours per day and must broadcast at least 3 hours per week of locally produced programming. The FCC has defined "locally produced programming" as programming "produced within the predicted Grade B contour of the station or within the predicted Grade B contours of any of the stations in a commonly-owned group," or programming produced at the station's main studio." 47 C.F.R. §73.6000.

WBXN-CD meets each of the continuing eligibility requirements. WBXN-CD broadcasts 24 hour per day, 7 days per week during this time period – well over the 18 hours per day required. Further, as detailed in the attached programming schedule, WBXN-CD broadcasts at least 3 hours per week of locally-produced programming.

In sum, at all relevant times, WBXN-CD has met the locally-produced programming requirement, and broadcasts more than 18 hours per day. Accordingly, it continues to be eligible for Class A status.
