LORAIN COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT For The Health of All of Us

Monthly interview Program with **Staff** from the L.C. General Health District covering difference health topics each month. Airs 10am – 10:30am once a month on WOBL and WDLW.

Thursday May 8, 2014 – 10:30am – 11:30am – Dave Covell, Executive Director of the Lorain County General Health District, was a guest with Nikki on WOBL and with Wally on WDLW. Dave talked about various ways that we can keep active and the blood flowing while we're at work. The benefits of short bursts of energy. Food safety tips – from cold foods to hot, how to handle leftovers, and the importance of washing your hands before and after handling foods. And, Mr. Covell stressed the importance of immunizations as the best way to ward off vaccine preventable diseases.

She also shared with our listeners a program on Adolescence and Drugs at the University Hospital Gates Auditorium on May 29th from 6pm – 9pm. Both events are free and open to the public.

Dan talked about the school, services offered there for developmentally handicapped people, the school districts served, and the structure of the classrooms. Mary, an attorney who's son attends Murray Ridge School, provided personal experience and a testimonial for the school. She also provides legal counsel to families with disabled youths.

Every other Wednesday, Joan Samkow from the L.C. Board of Mental Health brings a guest in to be interviewed on the air. Our intention is to instruct and teach our audience about mental health issues, to learn symptoms and signs or mental health problems or abuse and to let them know all the different services that are available in Lorain County.

Wednesday April 9, 2014 8am – 9am - Carol Peck and Tad Peck of The Lucy Idol Center were guest with Super Dave on WOBL and with Vietz on WDLW. The Center is located in Vermilion. It is a day treatment learning facility for mentally disabled adults in Lorain County. The two talked about what serviced they offer, they're about to celebrate their 60th anniversary, about the history of the Center, and inspiration to it's found and namesake. On site personnel include licensed physical therapist, music therapist, registered nurse, to name a few. They also work on transporation issues to get the mentally disabled to appointments.

Wednesday April 23, 2014 – 4pm-5pm – Nita Bring-Mazurek LSW, NCG, Program Director Volunteer Guardianship Program of Lorain County. Nita shared with Big John on WOBL and with Gene on WDLW, the mission of the program, how to volunteer, the criteria for volunteers and for those in need. Wednesday May 7, 2014 – 8am – 9am – Charlie Neff, Executive Director of the Lorain County Board of Mental Health, was a guest with Super Dave on WOBL and with Vietz on WDLW.

Wednesday May 21, 2014 - 4pm - 5pm – Lise Day, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Lorain County was a guest with Big John on WOBL and with Gene on WDLW. Lise shared with our listeners why it's so important for single mothers to find a mentor for their

children. She also talked about battle self doubt, that perhaps we're not doing all we can or all we should for our children. Lise also laid out what time commitment is required of someone who is considering becoming a Big.

Wednesday June 4, 2014 - 8am - 9am – Amy Denger, CEO of the Nord Center, was a guest with Super Dave on WOBL and with Brian Engle on WDLW. Amy discussed the role the Nord Center plays in providing relief services to parents who suddenly find their homes full of children now that school is out for the summer. She also talked about the dangers of opiate prescription medications, as a possible gateway to more dangerous heroin addiction. Amy provided some important contact information for people to use to reach out for help, either for themselves or a loved one.

She highlights 2 animals (dogs or cats) per week who are in foster care and in need of homes. Lorie has been very successful in highlighting awareness of the need for spaying and neutering your pets, the importance of immunizations, taking proper care of your animals/pets, etc.
