Monthly interview Program with **David Covell** from the L.C. General Health District covering difference health topics each month. Airs 10am - 10:30am once a month on WOBL and WDLW.

Thursday July 3, 2014 – 10am-11am – Scott – Environmental Health Mgr at LCGHD.

Thursday September 4th, 2014 – 10:00am – 11:00am - Katie Bevan, LCGHD, was a guest with Nikki on WOBL and with Wally on WDLW. Katie talked about falls among older adults and how a healthier lifestyle can decrease the chances of serious injury. She says just 15-minutes a day can build muscle and improve balance – ultimately preventing falls. She recommends eating vegetables that are rich in calcium like kale, broccoli, yogurt, almonds, etc. She also said the Health District will host a pair of blood pressure clinics on September 24th & 25th. In Oberlin on the 24th and in Wellington on the 25th.
