Monthly interview Program with **Ken Pierce** from the L.C. General Health District covering difference health topics each month. Airs 10am – 10:30am once a month on WOBL and WDLW.

Thursday April 5th, 2012 – LCHD Exec. Dir. Ken Pearce was a guest on “The Midday Café’ with Nikki” on WOBL and on “As You Like It with Wally” on WDLW. Ken’s biggest message today was the possitive health effects of just plain old walking. He said the calories burned while walking aren’t much lower than those burned while jogging. Ken said the biggest and likely most difficult step is to establish some sort of regular routine. He also suggested walks at different locations so we’re not seeing the same things each time.

Thursday May 3rd, 2012 – 10am – 11am - LCHD Exec. Dir. Ken Pearce was a guest on “The Midday Café’ with Nikki” on WOBL and on “As You Like It with Wally” on WDLW. Ken talked about the increase of bug activity as the weather improves and temperatures rise. He shared ideas for keeping ourselves protected from mosquitos and other insects that can bite, or sting. He also urged to keep an eye on areas around the

home where water can collect and pool – providing a perfect breeding ground for mosquitos.

Thursday June 7th, 2012 – 10am –11am - LCHD Exec. Dir. Ken Pearce was a guest on “The Midday Café’ with Nikki” on WOBL and on “As You Like It with Wally” on WDLW. Ken talked about the importance of water and staying hydrated during the hot summer months. And, if not, what can happen to a person’s body if it doesn’t get enough water...like heat exhaustion and heat stroke, and how to recognize the symptoms.

Thursday April 26th, 2012, 10am – 11am. Thomas and James Heffner (aka Melvin and Sebastian) along with Rudy from Rudy and the Illusions, were guest this morning on “The Midday Café’ with Nikki” on WOBL and on “As You Like It with Wally” on WDLW. They talked about a benefit concert taking place on Sunday April 29th at Lorain County Community College. Funds for the event will benefit the American Cancer Society. There will be lots of entertainment, live music, food, etc. It runs from noon until 7pm.

We then give details on the air of the pet that has been found or lost, along with a phone number for the person who is keeping the pet, or looking for the pet. We have been very successful in helping with finding lost pets and finding lost owners. This is a free service to anyone who has lost or found a pet.
