

## CERTIFICATION REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH VIDEO DESCRIPTION REQUIREMENTS



This is to certify that USA Network provided more than 1,700 hours of video-described programming and described over 90% of any newly produced non-live programming aired between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and midnight during the above referenced quarter. However, the video description rules of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) only allow a small fraction of those hours to count toward the quarterly requirement.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, USA Network aired a total of 84.2 hours of eligible described programming as calculated under the current FCC rules.
