ISSUES PROGRAMS

Third Quarter July August September 2022

1) We broadcast a show called THIS WEEK IN TEXAS produced by the Texas State Network. The show explores many different issues of concern to Texans. The show is a review of all major news stories in the state. The show is aired every Sunday from 5:00 till 5:30 am every Sunday morning. The show is broadcast on both KSEY FM and KSEY AM. An agenda for each show is attached at the end of this report.

2) Broadcast Live all regular meeting of the Seymour City Council. Meetings for the benefit of elderly residents in our community who might have a hard time attending meeting. In the Second Quarter meeting were broadcast on July 24, August 28 and September 25. The meeting time is 7:00pm is are broadcast on both KSEY FM and KSEY AM.

3) In Conjunction with the Seymour Chamber of Commerce KSEY produces a weekly 20 minute talk show called the CHAMBER CONNECTION. The shows focus is economic development, a serious issue in rural Texas. The show is broadcast every Friday at 9:15am, 12:20pm and 5:15pm. The shows are archived for review in the production computer in the control room. CHAMBER CONNECTION is broadcast on both KSEY FM and KSEY AM.

4) Baylor County and all of the KSEY listening area has a ag based economic and farm and ranch issues in the news are very important to our listeners. We broadcast 30 minutes of farm related news Monday thru Friday from 5:00 till 5:30am, 7:00am till 7:30am and 8:15am till 8:30am on KSEY AM and FM. An ag show is broadcast on KSEY FM Monday thru from 12:15pm till 1:00pm

5) Despite the fact that our area received some rain amount in September, we still are in a drought and face additional water consumption restrictions. KSEY AM FM continued to run a series of 30 second psa's urging residents to use water wisely. We broadcast 50 announcements per week on both KSEY AM and FM.

5) KSEY's EAS encoder-decoder has a telephone interface. The City of Seymour has access to the system to immediately broadcast local emergencies. We broadcast announcements informing listeners about the EAS system and how it works. Additionally, we stock EAS monitors that we'll sell to the community at cost. We broadcast 5 EAS PSAs per day on both KSEY FM and AM explaining what EAS is and how the system works.

6) Wildfires in Texas and Seymour have been a real problem this year because of little rain. There have been over 250 wildfires across the state this summer. KSEY has broadcast over 500 PSAs this quarter discussing wildfire safety.
