Issue: Faith and Politics

July 4, 2022 At 9:30 we aired an interview with Dan Fisher, Author of the Black Robed Regiment, for 25 minutes about how the clergy and church worked in the 18th century to influence freedom for the colonies and how we can do the same today.

Issue: Anxiety
