Consumer Issues – an example of this would be consumer recalls on items such as cars, food and baby products that could affect the health and safety of many viewers

Government Issues – An example would be ballot measures that effected the state such as the legalization of marijuana.

Minority Issues – An example would be stories regarding the protests of police brutality towards suspects of color.

Socio-Political Issues – An example would be ballet measures that propose the freedom for same-sex couples to marry.

LOCAL PROGRAMMING

KPTV NEWS ON KPDX AT 8:00PM AND 9:00PM

KPDX 49 airs an hour newscast Monday through Friday at 8:00pm and 9:00pm that is produced by KPTV FOX 12. This provides a high quality, informative newscast to KPDX's viewing public.

What follows is a sampling of the issues regularly treated in the 8pm and 9pm newscast on KPDX.

CONSUMER ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/5/17 8PM News, Running Time:1:00

This story focused on a warning to parents regarding a child's toy truck. One family said a drivable Tonka Truck they had for their son caught on fire. When the fire started, they tried to move it but the wheels kept turning and the flames kept returning after dousing with water. Dyna-Craft had put out a recall because the pedal could stick, but there was no mention of a fire hazard. The family wants others who purchased the Tonka Truck to be aware of the potential danger.

2. Air Date: 10/24/17 8PM News, Running Time: :25

This story focused on the reasons why Mitsubishi is recalling more than 160-thousand vehicles. The car manufacturer said electric relays can cause engines to stall or overheat and dealers will replace the part for free.

3. Air Date: 11/2/17 9PM News, Running Time: :35

This story focused on a recall of millions of fire extinguishers. The recall impacts more than 140 different models of Kidde Fire Extinguishers mad between 1973 and September 2017. That covers more than 37-million units. The Consumer Product Safety Commission said the extinguishers can become clogged, can require excessive force to discharge, or can simply fail to work in an emergency. They also said at least one death has been linked to the faulty extinguishers. Kidde will replace the extinguisher for free and give instructions on returning the faulty one.

4. Air Date: 11/20/17 8PM News, Running Time: :20

This story focused on a recall of some of Trader Joe's packaged salads because there may be pieces of plastic or glass inside. The recall included three types of salads, but only one of them, the "Turkey Cranberry Apple Salad" was sold in Washington and Oregon. Trader Joe's said to throw it out or return it for a refund.

5. Air Date: 12/15/17 8PM News, Running Time:4:55

This story focused on the subject of an FDA investigation involving a baby formula. A Portland mom said she bought a can of baby formula that would up being flour. The company that makes the baby formula considers it to be consistent with a type of retail return fraud since there is no flour at any of their processing plants that make the formula. The mom wanted to share her story because she's concerned other tainted cans of formula might still be out there. The company has since filed a complaint with the U.S. Food and Drug Administration since tampering with formula is considered a federal crime.

6. Air Date: 12/19/17 9PM News, Running Time: :25

This story focused on the increase in gas prices. Pump prices are 15 to 40 cents a gallon more than a year ago and are the most expensive prices since 2014. According to AAA, the national average for a gallon of regular is \$2.42. Oregon and Washington are among the states with the highest gas prices right now.

CRIME ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/2/17 9PM News, Running Time:7:40

This story focused on the deadly shooting that happened overnight in Las Vegas where a gunman open fired into a crowd of 22,000 who were attending a concert outside of Mandalay Bay Hotel. Over 50 people were killed and more than 500 were wounded. The gunman then killed himself before police broke into the room he was shooting from on the 32nd floor of the hotel.

2. Air Date: 10/31/17 9PM News, Running Time:2:15

This story focused on a 23-yr-old man will spend the rest of his life in prison after murdering two men at a Portland Pub two years ago. He shot 3 men after while arguing with them. Two of them died. Grieving relatives confronted him at his sentencing hearing. He apologized to the families and said he would take full responsibility for his actions.

3. Air Date: 11/14/17 8PM News, Running Time:5:30

This story focused on a closer look at racial intolerance and white supremacist thinking, and how it remains a problem here in Oregon. There seems to be a direct tie to Oregon's Prison System, which has become an incubator for hate groups. Reports on a recent riot looks to be a planned confrontation between members of white prison gangs, and members of a Latino Group called "Paisas." Inmates were punched in the back of the head, kicked in the face, and ultimately pepper sprayed by guards. The incident is a window into life behind bars in Oregon prisons. One former Skinhead, who served time at the state penitentiary, said he recruited new arrivals into white supremacist gangs. Prisons around the country have long been considered a breeding ground for organized crime and gang activity. A spokesman for NW Regional Re-Entry Center, said former gang members can be and have been reformed, but thinks more needs to be done to reform the prison system that produces them.

4. Air Date: 11/17/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:10

This story focused on how a shortage of state troopers effects how the law is enforced in Oregon. Compared to other states, Oregon has a considerable shortage of bodies to enforce the laws on state highways. According to population figures from the latest U.S. Census, Oregon has the lowest patrol troopers per 1000 people in the nation. One officer said they just don't have the resources they need to be out there with an enforcement presence that they'd like to have.

5. Air Date: 12/8/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:40

This story focused on an update in a case where a victim was found murdered in his burning home last November. Detectives now believe his death was the work of multiple suspects and that robbery was one of the motives. Investigators are taking a closer look at the evidence and hope to finally solve this crime with help from the public. Unique items were stolen and detectives hope someone may have seen them.

6. Air Date: 12/11/17 9PM News, Running Time:2:15

This story focused on the arrest of a man who kidnapped a woman and her child after her quick-thinking lead to his capture. The man was coming off a nearly six-year prison term from a 2011 sex abuse case. Now he's facing a slew of new felonies. Investigators said he broke into the woman's home and waited. When she arrived home with her child, he held them there at knifepoint overnight, threatening her and forcing her to undress. The next day, she convinced him to take them to a Dick's Sporting Goods store where she was able to mouth the words "help me" to other customers. It worked, and he was arrested. He's now charged with ten new felonies ranging from burglary and kidnapping, to coercion and unlawful use of a weapon.

ECONOMY ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/17/17 9PM News, Running Time: :25

This story focused on current unemployment rates. Oregon lost jobs for the second month in a row, but the unemployment rate was essentially unchanged. According to the Employment Department, about 38-hundred jobs were dropped in September, following 7-thousand in August. The slowdown comes after six months of rapid gains.

2. Air Date: 10/19/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:30

This story focused on a debate that continues over the right for Nestle to set up a water bottling plan in the Columbia River Gorge. Voters shot down a ballot measure to authorize the plant, however those plans are still moving forward. The city of Cascade Locks hasn't given up on the idea, and the issue may end up in court. An economist told the city it would bring a 23 million dollar a year overall impact to the city, but those who pushed for the ballot measure to block Nestle said the opposition won't back down either.

3. Air Date: 11/13/17 8PM News, Running Time:1:25

This story focused on a major development concerning a lifeline for Oregon's economy. The governor announced that Swire Shipping will begin container shipping service at Terminal Six starting in January. The terminal has essentially been abandoned since last year after 3 other firms pulled out of the port over labor union concerns. Swire representatives said they're planning to make monthly stops at the terminal, with exports of Oregon products to Australia and New Zealand. The governor said she hopes more shipping companies will follow and that the terminal's rebirth will bring more jobs to the state.

4. Air Date: 11/16/17 9PM News, Running Time:2:30

This story focused on a big GOP win on tax reform in the House. Republicans passed their version of tax reform. After the vote, the speaker noted there was plenty of work before tax reform is done. Senators against the bill said the tax package would favor corporations over other businesses and others worry about the impact on the nation's debt.

5. Air Date: 12/13/17 9PM News, Running Time: :19

This story focused on interest rates after the Federal Reserve raised them, signaling a healthy U.S. Economy. The Fed raised it one quarter percentage point which marks the third time the central bank has boosted rates this year. The Federal Chairman said low unemployment increased consumer spending and bigger investment by businesses drove the decision.

6. Air Date: 12/22/17 8PM News, Running Time:1:45

This story focused on the new Tax Bill signing by the president before he headed out for Christmas vacation. He said some large companies are already giving away bonuses or raising wages and he considers the bill a positive move for the middle class and jobs.

EDUCATION ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/9/17 8PM News, Running Time:1:05

This story focused on a local high school that is getting national recognition from the Special Olympics for achievements in inclusion. Special Olympics Oregon awarded Forest Grove High School a brand new banner for its efforts to provide inclusive sports and activities for students with and without disabilities. They are one of only 38 schools nationwide to receive this award.

2. Air Date: 10/19/17 8PM News, Running Time:4:05

This story focused on a project developed in Oregon called "The Mighty Endeavor" which uses students to save the legacies of World War Two Veterans. The goal is to create an historical account of every WW2 Veteran from the state of Oregon, while also providing an online resource for students, teachers and the general public for years to come. Local high school students learn to interview the remaining WW2 Veterans and build a connection to what they learn in school and what they hear happened from an actual participant in the historical event.

3. Air Date: 11/7/17 8PM News, Running Time: :55

This story focused on Oregon's biggest school districts and how they are struggling with overcrowding and bloated class sizes. One district is putting together a \$620 Million Bond Proposal to address overcrowding. Until the bond passes, teachers will continue to do the best they can with the space they have.

4. Air Date: 11/16/17 8PM News, Running Time:1:15

This story focused on a suit against the Oregon Department of Education and the Dallas School District. Several parents, teachers, and students say the student's rights are being violated. It's backed by a non-profit called Parents Rights in Education, along with a group called parents for privacy. They don't like the policies that were rolled out last year regarding transgender students. The lawsuit wants to change the rules requiring school officials to tread students according to the gender they identify with, including use of pronouns and restrooms. They said the rules violate student privacy and endanger student's safety. The ACLU and LGBTQ advocates held a conference to speak out against the lawsuit.

5. Air Date: 11/28/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:25

This story focused on a program that shares the gift of music with those who otherwise couldn't afford it. Project Prelude offers free music lessons to elementary students. The teachers and high school students are volunteers. A senior student from Gatlin Gabel started the program. Instruments left over from orchestra programs that have been cut are put to use once more. There is never a problem finding students interested to learn, since private lessons are so expensive.

6. Air Date: 12/1/17 9PM News, Running Time:2:20

This story focused on a local high school principals warning to his students and families about an E-Cigarette that's now popular with a lot of teens, called the "Juul." He said staff members are seeing more and more of them on campus. Adding to the problem, the little vaping devices are easy to conceal. The small devices are becoming a big problem all across the country. The principal said they are targeted directly at teens, especially girls, and are simple to convert to Marijuana Oil (THC).

7. Air Date: 12/29/17 8PM News, Running Time: :40

This story focused on an Oregon high school that may be looking for a new mascot. More than 100 students, parents, teachers, and community members presented a petition to the school to change its mascot, which currently is The Axemen. They said they want something more gender-neutral. School officials said they plan to hold discussions on the issue when students return from winter break.

ENVIRONMENT ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/5/17 9PM News, Running Time:3:55

This story focused on a growing concern across the country about the health of bees. They have been disappearing in alarming numbers. A recent study found that bees can be harmed by a commonly used pesticide called Neonicotinoids, even if it's used correctly. This year, the legislature considered a bill that would put in place more restrictions on neonics, but the bill died before it made it to the Senate floor. An Entomologist with Oregon State University's Extension Service said the importance of pesticides in agriculture means there will always be potential for pollinators and poisons to interact, but limiting pesticide use outside of agriculture is a viable option that could reduce the risks.

2. Air Date: 10/10/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:25

This story focused on how Hood River Growers are working together to reduce the amount of water they use on their farms in an effort to help conserve and minimize their impact on the area. The Hood River is the essence of this town. But there has been a growing number of people depleting the resource, and in turn, compromising the wildlife that depend on its water. The Hood River Farmers Irrigation District is now doing what it can to conserve water where it can. The district supplies all Hood River growers with water from rivers and streams. The district built hydropower into its system years ago with the idea of reinvesting any revenue from sales into more efficient ways to reduce water use. To eliminate waste in the canal system, it is now enclosing those canals in pipe which is already making an impact on water use. The growers are now working to use even less with micro sprinkler systems which have wound up yielding better-quality produce. It's a switch that's expensive, but so important to Hood River Conservationists.

3. Air Date: 11/3/17 9PM News, Running Time: :46

This story focused on a new exhibit at OMSI in Portland about the impact of climate change on the arctic. The exhibit teaches visitors about permafrost and shows how people can help the environment. An Oregon Senator is working to secure continued funding for scientific research.

4. Air Date: 11/16/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:10

This story focused on a new ordinance that goes into effect starting next year that will help the environment. The City of Portland is now requiring sellers of single0family homes to have an energy score ranging from one to ten. The Portland City Council unanimously adopted the policy as part of the city's Climate Action Plan. It includes a goal to reduce carbon emissions by 80% by 2050. That's compared to 1990. A licensed certified company will need to do the inspection which will look at the building itself, insulation, the water heater, heating, and cooling. When a home is listed, it must include the score.

5. Air Date: 12/7/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:45

This story focused on a new decision from the federal government that isn't sitting well with people in the Columbia River Gorge. The current administration plans to roll back safety measures for oil trains, meant to protect against crashes and spills. It was just last summer when a train derailed in Mosier, leading to a lot of anger in the community about oil trains in the Gorge and the risks when it comes to safety and the environment. According to the Associated Press, the administration said the safety measures would cost three times the benefit they'd produce. An Oregon senator said that degrading oil train safety requirements is a huge stop backward and one that puts our land, homes, and lives at risk.

6. Air Date: 12/12/17 9PM News, Running Time:2:20

This story focused on a global climate summit that is underway in Paris. The French President is pushing forward with the Paris Climate Accord without U.S. involvement. President Trump announced America's withdrawal earlier this year. A universal and binding climate change treaty aimed at keeping global warming below 2 degrees Celsius above preindustrial levels was a deal that few had imagined possible. After President Trump withdrew from the deal, the French president launched a draft Global Charter for the environment. The question is whether Paris, as determined as it is, has the power to lead even where the United States refuses to follow.

GOVERNMENT ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/4/17 9PM News, Running Time: 1:10

This story focused on the extension of the city's housing emergency for another 18 months. The Portland City Council voted to approve the extension which was first declared in October, 2015, then extended in September of last year. The declaration is an attempt to combat homelessness and high housing costs. In February, city commissioners voted to pass an ordinance requiring landlords to pay renters' moving fees if they are evicted for no reason, or if the tenant decides to move out after rent is increased by more than 10% within a year. That ordinance is now extended to December, when they may introduce a permanent version.

2. Air Date: 10/12/17 8PM News, Running Time: :45

This story focused on new legislation that will require all grand jury testimony in the State of Oregon to be audio recorded. Currently, grand jury notes are handwritten and often incomplete. A grand jury is essentially a private meeting where prosecutors present evidence to seven jurors who listen to witness testimony and determine if it's all enough to charge someone with a crime. The defense is excluded from these4 proceedings and there's no official record of what happened. This new bill changes that and will impact Oregon's most vulnerable victims.

3. Air Date: 11/21/17 8PM News, Running Time:1:30

This story focused on how the federal government wants to make a major shift in the way the internet is regulated. The FCC wants to repeal Obama-Era protections intended to keep the internet open and fair, called Net Neutrality. Under the current rules, internet providers are not allowed to deliberately speed up or slow down traffic from specific websites and apps like Netflix or YouTube. If those rules are repealed, broadband companies will be able to determine what websites and online services customers can see and use. The FCC will vote on the repeal at its monthly hearing on December 14th.

4. Air Date: 11/27/17 9PM News, Running Time:2:00

This story focused on lawmakers who are back on Capitol Hill after Thanksgiving Break and face looming year-end deadlines. Passing the GOP's Tax Reform Bill isn't the only battle facing Republicans. The deadline to pass a spending bill to avoid a government shutdown is also quickly approaching. Plus, congress still needs to raise the debt ceiling to avoid defaulting on loans. However, sexual misconduct scandals continue to distract lawmakers.

5. Air Date: 12/8/17 8PM News, Running Time: :55

This story focused on the approval of a spending bill that will keep the federal government running for another two weeks. Now lawmakers face the challenge of passing a long-term spending bill. In order to do so, republicans and democrats have to hammer out policy difference. They'll debate issues like defense spending and immigration. Democrats also said they want a fix for DACA.

6. Air Date: 12/11/17 8PM News, Running Time: :40

This story focused on a new decision in the legal battle over transgender troops. They will be free to enlist in the New Year. A federal judge declined the U.S. Government's request to put on hold an order allowing transgender individuals to join the military beginning in January.

HEALTH ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/2/17 9PM News, Running Time:1:20

This story focused on the overuse of antibiotics in the United States which can lead to resistance, a deadly and growing problem. Antibiotic resistance is the ability of a given bacteria to fight off the effects of an antimicrobial drug. Instead of being killed off, the bacteria survives and continues to multiply. This means that illnesses that were once easy to treat, could become dangerous infections. Sometimes, drug-resistant infections can lead to death. The CDC said over prescription and misuse of antibiotics are the main culprits, so take antibiotics only when they're needed.

2. Air Date: 10/26/17 9PM News, Running Time:2:55

This story focused on President Trump's declaration that the Opioid Crisis is a public health emergency. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, more than 140 Americans die every day from an Opioid overdose which is four times the amount in 1999. The presidents said he's trying to change that. The order, under the Public Health Services Act, will direct federal agencies to give more grant money to fight the epidemic. An Oregon Congressman also supports the president's decision calling it a "deadly, deadly crisis."

3. Air Date: 11/8/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:15

This story focused on a report from the American College of Chest Physicians that said none of the cough remedy items on the market have been proven to work at calming a nasty cough. Researchers reviewed clinical trial data on everything from cough syrups to Zinc and came to some less-than positive conclusions. They could not find evidence supporting most home remedies. On another subject, researchers found that IUD contraceptive devices may reduce a woman's risk of cervical cancer by about a third. They think IUD's might promote an immune response that kills off Human Papillomavirus, the virus that causes virtually all cases of cervical cancer.

4. Air Date: 11/10/17 8PM News, Running Time:1:55

This story focused on solutions to fight high suicide rates among military veterans which are highest in Western U.S. and rural areas. Local politicians made a visit to the VA Center in Portland to give their encouragement and support, but also to push for more to be done to help vets who are struggling. They note that suicide rates in the West are 7% higher than the rest of the country. They said the expansion of the Veteran's Crisis Line and increases in mental health services for the women, including Telehealth medicine are moves in the right direction. But agree more can be done, and veterans agree.

5. Air Date: 12/6/17 8PM News, Running Time: :55

This story focused on ways to cope with holiday stress such as exercise. High-intensity exercise is linked to mood-enhancing benefits such as the body releasing a chemical called endorphins, which trigger positive feelings. Yoga or meditation was suggested to relax or running outside for some fresh air.

6. Air Date: 12/20/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:00

This story focused on a health watch regarding a notice to Oregon State University Students. They must get a meningococcal Vaccine after a recent outbreak of the potentially deadly disease on campus. Before they come back to campus, school officials said they need to get vaccinated to protect themselves and others from this dangerous bacteria. In the past 13 months, there have been six cases of the disease at OSU's Corvallis Campus, most recently involving a 21-year-old student. Without antibiotics, experts said Meningococcal Disease can be deadly.

MINORITY ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/6/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:05

This story focused on a meeting with two Oregon Congressmen who came to Portland to talk about the fight to renew the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program application process for children of undocumented immigrants after the current one expired. They also wanted to meet some of its recipients who are now in limbo. The democratic senators used the opportunity to reassure a couple dozen dreamers and other immigration rights advocates that they are both fighting for them. The dreamers had until yesterday to reapply for a two-year renewal. The president also gave congress six months to pass a new bill on the issue.

2. Air Date: 10/25/17 9PM News, Running Time: :26

This story focused on a suggestion by the Civil Rights Group, the NAACP, which said that African Americans may want to avoid American Airlines because it appeared the carrier may have a "corporate culture of racial insensitivity and possible racial bias." The organization said it has seen a "pattern of disturbing incidents reported by African-American Passengers." A spokesperson for the airline responded by saying their company is committed to providing positive and safe travel for everyone.

3. Air Date: 11/1/17 9PM News, Running Time:1:40

This story focused on students at Reed College who have been camped out in the president's office in an effort to protest perceived racial inequality on campus. A group called "Reedies Against Racism" were leading the protest and members said they will keep at it until the college changes its curriculum and ideology regarding race. The students are protesting school policies and programs that they feel misrepresent people of color, including a required humanities course they call Euro-Centric and "white washed". Administrators have issued around 2-dozen no contact orders to protesters who they said barged into the college treasurer's office last week.

4. Air Date: 11/9/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:35

This story focused on demonstrations around the country calling for congress to pass a new Dream Act. In Oregon, students gathered on the step of the capitol, chanting and holding signs. It was part of a national Day of Action for the Dream Act. Since the president announced he's ending the DACA Program, young people are now pushing congress to come up with a new plan to protect children who've grown up in this country. Immigrant activists said congress needs to create a new and fair plan to protect DACA recipients.

5. Air Date: 12/6/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:35

This story focused on students and staff at a local college who were joining people in the community to brainstorm solutions after white supremacist posters showed up on campus and at campuses around the country as well. Now students and staff are fighting back. Dozens showed up for a community meeting on campus to discuss fears, feelings, and how to combat the problem. College leaders put together the meetings to validate people's concerns, but also to solicit solutions.

6. Air Date: 12/11/17 8PM News, Running Time: :40

This story focused on a new decision in the legal battle over transgender troops. They will be free to enlist in the New Year. A federal judge declined the U.S. Government's request to put on hold an order allowing transgender individuals to join the military beginning in January.

SOCIO-POLITICAL ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/6/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:05

This story focused on a round table discussion were two democratic senators reassured dreamers and other immigration rights advocates that they are fighting for the renewal of the DACA Program after the president announced last month that it would be cut. However, he did put in a six-month delay for those under the program that are set to have their statuses expire this coming spring.

2. Air Date: 10/20/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:50

This story focused on a controversial video showing immigration enforcement officials arresting an undocumented worker inside a local home. Some questioned whether it was legal or not. The director for the ACLU of Oregon said the video brought up several issues. He said law enforcement cannot enter a home without a warrant, and even if consent is given to come inside, it can be revoked. He said the agents had no right to be there. A spokesperson for ICE said the man had been released from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement custody pending further investigation regarding the circumstances of his arrest.

3. Air Date: 11/16/17 8PM News, Running Time: 1:15

This story focused on a suit against the Oregon Department of Education and the Dallas School District. Several parents, teachers, and students say the student's rights are being violated. It's backed by a non-profit called Parents Rights in Education, along with a group called parents for privacy. They don't like the policies that were rolled out last year regarding transgender students. 4. Air Date: 12/5/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:40

This story focused on a decision being made by the Supreme Court on a case regarding whether or not shops can deny making wedding cakes for same-sex couples. The particular case came from a Colorado baker who claimed "religious liberty" when he refused to bake a cake for a same-sex couple. It's similar to an Oregon case of a bakery who were fined 135-thousand dollars for refusing to make a wedding cake for a lesbian couple. Attorneys for the Colorado baker said every American should be concerned if the court rules that the government can compel individuals to speak in a way that offends their beliefs. While attorneys for the other side argue that business owners who enter the stream of commerce, can't pick and choose their customers.

5. Air Date: 12/4/17 9PM News, Running Time:1:40

This story focused on response to a weekend protest outside the Columbia Store in Downtown Portland. The company is responding to criticism regarding the homeless issues downtown. The CEO of the company had written an Op-Ed piece published a month ago claiming he was concerned about the safety of his employees in downtown Portland. He now says he refuses to give up and wants to encourage all Oregonians to devote time, attention and resources to address the complex issues surrounding homelessness. At the same time, he thinks we can and should provide resources for law enforcement to provide greater safety for all.

SAFETY ISSUES

1. Air Date: 10/10/17 8PM News, Running Time: :45

This story focused on a drill for local first responders to practice working together in case a real emergency ever happened. They pretended a drone was releasing toxic chemicals into a local stadium and their job was to get people out safely. The drill was practiced again and again. According to TSA Officials, its purpose was to make sure first responders know how to coordinate with each other in a chaotic situation, which meant police, TSA, Trimet and the fire department needed to be able to work together in a time of crisis.

2. Air Date: 10/25/17 8PM News, Running Time: :15

This story focused on a recall of 63-thousand infant seats by Fisher Price because of a fire hazard. The company has received 36 reports of the Soothing Motion Seats overheating and one report of a fire. Five models are being recalled.

3. Air Date: 11/1/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:25

This story focused on a new program that was started by Oregon State Prosecutors to keep witnesses safe. It's called the Witness Intimidation Support Program. State prosecutors said gang and trafficking cases are compromised all the time because witnesses are fearful to testify in court. They are hopeful this new program will change that. Witnesses involving a case with a high degree of risk are provided protection by law enforcement along with funds for relocation and basic monthly expenses.

4. Air Date: 11/8/17 8PM News, Running Time:3:05

This story focused on serious safety concerns at a mental health treatment center for teens and adolescents. The facility is now the center of an investigation by Child Protective Services and DHS. One parent said his daughter was being treated for depression and anxiety at the facility but received a call telling him that the director of the facility had been removed and there were a number of safety violations. DHS released a list of preliminary findings including a series of safety issues, and violation of the facility's license. DHS has put several restrictions on the facility and ordered them to stop admitting new patients.

5. Air Date: 12/19/17 8PM News, Running Time:2:00

This story focused on a safety feature that could have helped stop the deadly train derailment that happened in Washington. It's called Positive Train Control, which can automatically slow down and stop a train if it senses the locomotive is going too fast or could get into an accident. The train was set to have the feature installed sometime in 2018. The Federal Railroad Administration has called the system the "single-most important rail safety development in more than a century." The deadline to install the safety feature had been extended to the end of 2018 by congress because several railroad companies threatened to shut down services unless they were given more time to install the complex technology.

6. Air Date: 12/29/17 8PM News, Running Time:1:55

This story focused on New Year's Eve safety tips. The big thing to remember is to drive sober. Police will be out in force to make sure the roads are safe. A chart on duidrivinglaws.org gives an idea of how many drinks it takes to reach your limit according to your weight. Transportation options were given such as Trimet offering free rides as well as the Portland Streetcar. Ride-sharing services such as Lyft and Uber were also recommended along with a discount code.
