WRBP-FM, WGFT-AM and WASN-AM were formally owned by Fortress Investments.

WRBP-FM was sold to Educational Media Foundation and closed on December 31, 2012 and ceased operations.

Although Fortress continued to own WGFT-AM and WASN-AM, they filed STA's and ceased operations on December 31, 2012 as well. The stations were dark until Y-Town Radio Broadcasting, LLC purchased both properties and began operations in May of 2014.

Consequently, there were no Issues and Program programming during the interim.
