D. Outreach Activities

- 1. Announcements were placed on all station websites notifying organizations of their right to request information on job openings
- 2. An internship program is offered to bring awareness to job opportunities in broadcasting available at WVRC. We had two interns with our MetroNews Sports Broadcasting.
- 3. Corporate Promotions Director and a Corporate Sales Manager of WVRC Media co-hosted a Media Day for the Leadership Monongalia group at the corporate offices of WVRC Media. Jobs about broadcasting were discussed as well as a tour of the facilities. This was on November 16,2023.
- 4. Corporate HR Liason/Assistant to the President and the Corporate Promotions Director attended Fairmont State University's Spring Job Fair on March 27, 2024 from 8am-2pm. Many discussions about Broadcasting, Digital Marketing, and Sales were covered with approximately 50+ students. WVRC Media was a Co-Sponsor of this event.
- 5. Corporate HR Liason/Assistant to the President and the Corporate Promotions Director attended a Job Fair hosted by Monongalia County Technical Education Center on April 12, 2024. The event ran 8am-12pm. Over 75 students were talked to about opportunities in broadcasting.
- 6. Corporate HR Liason/Assistant to the President participated in a Workforce WV Virtual Job fair on April 3, 2024. This was from 1pm-3:30pm. Over 1000 Registrants participated and was able to read about and see open positions with WVRC Media. Many registrants directly contacted WVRC Media to inquire about open positions and opportunities in broadcasting.
