They were followed by Lewis County at 7.2 percent, Elliott County with 7.1 percent, and Woodford County with the lowest jobless rate in the commonwealth at 2.9 percent.

The recovery efforts from the floods of 2022 continue. During his visits to Eastern Kentucky, Governor Andy Beshear announced an effort to restore the trees lost to the floods. There are 1,500 trees that will be planted in Letcher, Perry, and Breathitt counties. The Governor said the trees will be offered at no cost to the homes, schools, businesses, and other local organizations that are eligible.
