For the above referenced quarter, WOAY-TV has identified the following as critical issues and matters of importance to the community it serves:

1. Infrastructure – Impact on shipping, train transportation, and economic implications of CSX train derailment in Summers County, WV; safety concerns after massive sinkhole develops in Hinton, new bridge in Beckley.
2. Economic and finance – banking collapse and financial concerns, inflation and consumer pricing/impacts on local goods and services.
3. Legislative/Legal – new bills signed into law by Governor Justice after the legislative session.
4. Education and Children – Including access to programs and services for at-risk youth, academics, services provided by schools, access to programs, and services for at-risk youth.
5. Community – School protest for terminal cancer patient and whether or not he is permitted to remain in school; activities and events for various community demographics; resources and support for vulnerable citizens.
6. National Government and legal – including the lead-up to former President Trump's indictment; issues relating to the Russian/Ukraine conflict.
7. Health/Well-Being: Health and wellness information concerning a variety of topics, including: information relating to Covid-19 and its variants, physical and mental health, safety concerns, medical issue awareness and education, health care, and access to treatment.

Forum

Forum is a locally produced public affairs show, which addresses various topics and issues of community importance. Forum airs on Sunday mornings at 11:30am. The following list provides the weekly topic(s) and a brief summary of community information provided by the guest(s).

1/1/23 – Today’s guest is Mr. John Wyatt, locally known as “The Appalachian.” John is a well-known minister, radio personality, musician, city councilman, and public speaker in our area. Each year around the New Year, Wyatt joins the show to discuss the Appalachian way of life and our unique culture.

1/8/23 – Today’s guest is Mr. Dave Perry, who is a local educator and politician in the area. Dave joins us before the West Virginia legislative session to give us a rundown of the year’s agenda. In addition to serving in the Legislature, Perry is on the Oak Hill City Council. Perry discussed the new incentives that Oak Hill is implementing to get more business into the town. One big issue in recent months has been the City’s purchase of the former BB&T bank building. Perry confirmed that the city is buying the building and that it will be used for a new City Hall.

1/15/23 – Mr. Glen Jarrell joins the show today, as a member of the WV Trophy Hunters Association. Jarrell talked about the 35th Annual West Virginia Hunting and Fishing Show at the Charleston Convention Center. The show will run from January 20th through the 22nd. Mr. Jarrell gave a rundown of the many events they have scheduled this year. All proceeds are donated to programs to protect hunting, fishing, and wildlife conservation in West Virginia. Donations now exceed \$115,000.

1/22/23 – Today’s guest is Mr. Scott Miller, who is the Executive Director of the Just For Kids Advocacy Center in Beckley. The center provides a child-friendly atmosphere for interviews and therapy sessions for children who have been abused. The center will be having a special “sneaker donation” collection campaign in January. Mr. Miller also discussed the importance of the center and how financial contributions can help alleviate costs of the center.

1/29/23 – Molly Williams joins the show today, as the Executive Director of Raleigh County Parks and Recreation Authority. They are seeking community partners to raise funds for three all-inclusive playgrounds at a cost of one million dollars. The playgrounds will be located at Dry Hill Park, Fitzpatrick Park, and Lake Stephens. The new endeavor is called Energy Generating Handicapped Accessible Playgrounds.

2/5/23 – Today’s guest is Lori McKinney of the Princeton Renaissance Committee. McKinney is speaking about a program called “We Need to Talk,” which is in the Mercer County area. It consists of people who have opposing ideas and outlooks, and they make short videos of their beliefs and exchange them online. Viewers were shown some examples of the videos during the show as well.

2/12/23 – Today’s guest is Caitlin Pauley, Pauley is the Program Director for NECCO, which is a foster parents recruiting organization in the Southern West Virginia area. NECCO appeals to viewers to consider becoming a foster parent and adopting a child. West Virginia has a well-known problem with the lack of available foster parents and families. This is a program also being addressed in the legislature.

2/19/23 – For today’s show, viewers were able to learn about some historical aspects from the New River Gorge National Park and Preserve. We showed a documentary brought to us by the Fayette County Chamber of Commerce about the building of our famous New River Gorge Bridge. It is the largest arch steel stand bridge in North America. The documentary takes us through the process from the beginning to end of how the bridge was constructed. After completion, there was a large ceremony hosted by then Governor Jay Rockefeller. Each year since the completion of the bridge, there is an annual Bridge Day celebration, where people come to BASE jump from all over the world.

2/26/23 – Joining the show today is Major Mott, of the Beckley Salvation Army. Mott came to give us a progress report on the construction of their new fourteen million dollar building. Mott also discussed the facilities they envision for the new building. A date has been set of May 24th for the opening of the new facility, which will serve area residents.

3/5/23 – Today, Robby Moore joins our show on behalf of the Beckley Art Center. Moore discussed the spring fundraiser which will be on Saturday, March 11 from 4pm to 8pm at Weathered Ground Brewery in Cool Ridge. Some of the planned events include a raffle, silent auction, and live music. The Center is fundraising to offset costs associated with running the Beckley Art Center, which provides programs for the community.

3/12/23 – Today’s guest is Dr. Amelia Courts of the Educational Alliance. The Alliance is a Charleston based organization that has been present in West Virginia since the 1980s. Their mission is to bring business into West Virginia, to help with Education. The WV education system has been a benefactor of this organization and its success.

3/19/23 – Today’s guest is Dave Perry, who is a former school principal and State Delegate. Dave comes to discuss the recent WV Legislative session and give a synopsis of which bills

passed and failed. Dave is also an Oak Hill City Councilman and he talked about the new incentives the city is implementing to attract more business into the town.

3/26/23 – Today's guests include Erin Stone, the Assistant Executive Director, and Twana Warner, Sexual Assault Advocate, both of AWAY. AWAY used to be called The Women's Resource Center for Battered Women. The guests talked about the organization, which is a refuge for battered and abused women. April is National Sexual Assault Awareness Month, and they are trying to bring awareness to this all common issue. The guests elaborated that AWAY is a secured and guarded compound, which serves to protect women in Raleigh and surrounding counties.

I Have Been Watching

Antonio Armstrong — a former NFL player turned successful business owner — and his wife, Dawn Armstrong, raised what seemed to be a picture-perfect Texas family centered on faith and football. But on a fateful night in July 2016, everything changed when their then 16-year-old son AJ called 911 and reported that he heard gunshots from their room. When police arrived, they found the murder weapon had been left behind along with a mysterious note that read, “I’ve been watching for a long time.” In a new “**20/20**,” ABC News chief national correspondent Matt Gutman has the first network interview with AJ, who was quickly identified as the prime suspect by authorities.

Friday, January 13, 2023

Horror in Idaho: Student Murders

Terror gripped the rural town of Moscow, Idaho, when authorities found four University of Idaho students — Ethan Chapin (20), Madison Mogen (21), Xana Kernodle (20) and Kaylee Goncalves (21) — stabbed to death in an off-campus house in November. The case quickly made national headlines as police worked to identify a suspect and piece together answers to the puzzling crime. A shocking break in the case occurred when authorities arrested Bryan Kohberger, a 28-year-old Ph.D. student at Washington State University, as the primary suspect and charged him with four counts of first-degree murder. ABC News correspondent Kayna Whitworth reports.

What the Little Girl Saw

When former semi-pro hockey player Thomas Clayton found his wife, Kelley Clayton, murdered in their New York home one night after a late poker game, he called 911 in

distress. But as police investigated, they discovered evidence calling Thomas' motives into question and sensed something more sinister at play. A new "20/20" reveals the twisted plot behind the gruesome murder of the mother. ABC news correspondents Deborah Roberts and Byron report.

New Year's Evil

When Shele Covlin — a 47-year-old mother of two and successful banker — is found dead in her bathtub in her luxury apartment on the Upper West Side of Manhattan, it seems at first like a tragic accident. But family members quickly grow suspicious of her estranged husband, Rod Covlin, especially after authorities exhume her body and come to a shocking conclusion: Shele was strangled. ABC News correspondent and Deborah Roberts reports.

Killed or Be Killed?

When a father of two ends up dead, was it a case of self-defense or murder? Mother of two Nikki Addimando admitted to police that she shot and killed her partner, beloved gymnastics coach Chris Grover, in their home. But did she pull the trigger in self-defense after enduring years of physical and sexual abuse at the hands of Grover, or did she stage the crime scene and murder her partner in cold blood? But what was really going on in Julie and Mark's marriage, and could it have led to her murder? Double Life

Who would kill a mother-daughter pair in cold blood? Engaged to be married and designing her wedding dress, Angel was killed just weeks before her wedding. Her mother, also a victim, lived long enough to speak with police. But when everyone with access to the house had an airtight alibi and authorities found no physical evidence, the police were stumped — until the case took a shocking turn. A Model Murder

Kelsey Turner seemed made for Las Vegas: an Instagram model with a Playboy past and a lavish lifestyle. But behind the scenes, an unexpected figure was financing her life of luxury. Dr. Thomas Burchard, a 71-

year-old child psychiatrist and well-respected community member, was doling out his life savings to support the flashy influencer. When Burchard was found dead in a car, abandoned in the desert, the illusion of this Instagram-worthy lifestyle comes quickly crashing down as investigators set their sights on Turner and her boyfriend, Jon Logan Kennison. “20/20,” ABC News contributor **Chris Connelly** reports.

Alex Murdaugh Trial

It's the mystery the whole country is talking about right now. Alex Murdaugh, the patriarch of a Southern legal dynasty, stands accused of murdering his wife and son, Maggie and Paul Murdaugh. One of the most powerful families in South Carolina, the Murdaughs made headlines in 2019 when Paul was involved in a boating accident that resulted in the death of 19-year-old Mallory Beach. Since then, a string of unusual events has unraveled in the public eye. With his murder trial now wrapping up, jurors have to answer this question: Did Alex murder his family to distract from his mounting financial crimes? This two-hour “20/20” breaks down the gripping, ongoing trial, Alex’s not-guilty plea, and digs into the possible motives alleged by prosecutors behind these brutal murders.

Andrea Cincotta

Chris Johnson and Andrea Cincotta were the picture-perfect image of an engaged couple. But everything changed one tragic night in August 1998, when Johnson found his fiancée lifeless in a closet in their shared apartment. Police peg Johnson as the killer after he confesses during interrogations that spanned 28 hours over three days. But when the details fail to add up, they are left asking: Who really killed Andrea Cincotta? A new “20/20” reports on the twists and turns in the investigation.

The Last Strike

When mother of two Nikki Entzel reported a house fire at her North Dakota home in January 2020, it appeared to be a senseless tragedy when police found her husband Chad Entzel’s badly burned body still inside. As investigators dug deeper, inconsistencies at the crime scene and in Nikki’s story revealed something more sinister at play. A new “20/20” reports on the dangerous love triangle between Nikki, Chad and Earl Howard and how it ended with murder and arson. ABC News correspondent **John Quiñones** reports.

You’ve Got Jail

Sharee Miller sat in the center of a complicated love triangle. She used sex, deception and the internet to pit her lover, Jerry Cassaday, a former police officer and casino worker she met in an online chatroom, against Bruce Miller, her unwitting husband. In online conversations with Cassaday, Miller faked losing multiple pregnancies at the hands of Bruce, who she falsely claimed physically abused her and had ties to the mafia. Soon after she told these lies, both men wound up dead. More than 20 years after her sentencing to life in prison, Miller sat down for an interview with “Nightline” co-anchor Juju Chang. Miller confesses to her crimes.

Running Out of Time

When Lauren McCluskey, a student-athlete at The University of Utah, met a bouncer at a local bar, it seemed like the start of a fairy-tale romance. Lauren’s friends grew concerned by his increasingly controlling behavior and urged her to stop seeing him. Lauren discovered that her boyfriend wasn’t who he said he was — his real name was Melvin Rowland, a 37-year-old sex offender who had recently been released from prison. Lauren ended the relationship and contacted campus police when he began extorting and harassing her. After over a week of repeatedly asking campus police, local law enforcement and school officials for help, Lauren was kidnapped and later found dead in a car. “20/20,” anchor David Muir and ESPN journalists T.J. Quinn and Nicole Noren report.
