For the above referenced quarter, WOAY-TV has identified the following as critical issues and matters of importance to the community it serves:

- 1. Environment Followed several substantial area fires in Raleigh and Fayette Counties, including a major brush fire in the New River Gorge National Park in which over one thousand acres burned, in addition to other local fires encompassing hundreds of acres. Also, continuing coverage of the controversial Mountain Valley Pipeline, court filings, and pipeline construction progress.
- 2. Government Local Housing Authority's removal of historic wall which was on the National Historic Register and Memo of Agreement between all parties with resolutions that benefited citizens with a new park and garden created from historic stones. Also, the demolition of buildings in historic towns along the New River which is now encompassed in the National Park.
- 3. Health and Wellness Effects of smoke from local fires on air quality near fires and surrounding towns. Various seasonal wellness topics applicable to the general population. Updated information about covid, flu, and rapidly spreading RSV.
- 4. Elections/Political Issues Hearing from candidates who will be running in the upcoming primary elections for local, state, and federal offices. Also, whether or not the City of Beckley will make a ballot issue of transitioning to a city-manager style of local government, versus a council vote. Also, Attorney General Patrick Morrissey and his successful lawsuit regarding the transfer rule and its impact on collegiate level sports.
- 5. Economy and Tourism Economic impact from the annual Bridge Day event in Fayetteville at the New River Gorge National Park.
- 6. Community and Culture Following the trek of the Capitol Christmas Tree from it being cut in the Monongahela Forest as it travelled to Nicholas and Raleigh Counties, and eventually finding its home in front of the U.S. Capitol. Also, numerous holiday events and charitable opportunities provided for those in need, as well as experiences for the general public.

Forum is a locally produced public affairs show, which addresses various topics and issues of community importance. Forum airs on Sunday mornings at 11:30am. The following list provides the weekly topic(s) and a brief summary of community information provided by the guest.

10/1/23 – Today's guest was Dr. Kristy Dumas, who is the President of the Beckley Rotary Club. Dumas discussed, in general, Rotary International and their mission. Dumas provided much detail about this year's theme and their important relationship with the Appalachian Regional Hospital.

10/8/23 – Today's guest was Erin Stone, of AWAY. AWAY is the relatively new name for the organization previously known as the Women's Resource Center, which helps women in domestic abuse situations. October is domestic violence awareness month and Stone talked about the events that they have scheduled during the month of October. There are two fundraisers at Liberty High School, a volleyball game on October 24th and a football game on October 27th. There will also be a Purple Hearts Gals on October 26th. AWAY will have candlelight vigil throughout the month to help bring awareness to domestic violence, and increase AWAY's visibility for those seeking help.

10/15/23 – Today's guest is Mr. Tim Naylor, who is the Executive Assistant at the Fayette County Chamber of Commerce and New River Visitors Bureau. Today, Naylor talked about Bridge Day, which is one of Southern West Virginia's biggest events of the year. This year, Bridge Day will take place on Saturday, October 21st. Naylor wanted to make the public aware of new traffic patterns and shuttle bus services for the event. With huge crowds, it takes much planning and assistance from the public to make the event a success. Visitors can watch BASE jumpers parachute from one of the longest arch bridges in the world, as well as enjoy the dozens of vendors along Route 19.

10/22/23 – Today guest is Mr. Al Boland, who is the Vice President of Operations for WVU Medicine at Princeton Community Hospital. They are now fifty years old and have been going through an expansion project. In January of 2023, Princeton Hospital combined with WVU School of Medicine to increase the services that are offered. The new CATLab provides greater options so that cardiac patients may have local care versus being transported to other hospitals.

10/29/23 – Today's guest is Scott Miller, who is the Executive Director of Just For Kids. Miller is set for retirement and has been a Forum participant several times. Just For Kids is a child friendly atmosphere where children may comfortably talk to care givers about abuse they are experiencing, or have experienced. Just For Kids is actively seeking donations to fund their new location, which is a warm inviting home uptown, as opposed to their previous office location.

11/5/23 – Today's guest is Ms. Lori McKinney of the Princeton Renaissance Committee. Also joining the show is Je'Dah Madison, who is an artist. McKinney has an on-line program called "We Need to Talk" and she is based in the Mercer County area. The show consists of people with different points of view making short videos of their beliefs and an on-line discussions of their views. McKinney discusses her third installment, which is called "A Special Preview of Wild and Wonderful."

11/12/23 – Today's guest is Kelly Elkins, who is the youth SADD Coordinator. Also joining is Kellie Gunnoe, who is the Executive Director of Raleigh County Family Support Center. The guests talked about the Raleigh County Prevention Coalition (RCPC). This is an organization that addresses the substance abuse problem in Raleigh County, particularly with young people

and their decision making. The guests discussed their Narcan training events that are scheduled and why this is so important for people in the area.

11/19/23 – Todays guests are Jennifer Heaster and Lora Stevens. Heaster and Stevens discussed this year's Toys for Tots campaign. Several area businesses have allowed the collection boxes to be placed in their establishments, which is greatly appreciated. Toys for Tots locally has combined with the Marine Corps and the former local Mac's Toy Fund to make Christmas a special event for the area's numerous underprivileged youth.

11/26/23 – Today's guest is Captain Liz Blusiewicz of the Salvation Army. She talked about the Christmas Kettle drive for the holiday season. Liz also discussed the new building in Beckley that is nearing completion, despite numerous delays. She explained the many advantages the new building will offer to the public, such as the Boys and Girls Club, which is kicking off in January.

12/3/23 – Today's guest Kelly Elkins, who is the SADD Youth Coordinator. Also joining Elkins, is Kellie Gunnoe, who is the Executive Director of the Raleigh County Family Support Center. They talked about the Raleigh County Prevention Coalition, which is an organization addressing the substance abuse problem in Raleigh County. They also discussed Narcan training events, which the public can utilize.

12/10/23 – Today's guest is Bobby Pack, who is with the Mt. Hope Jubilee Committee. Pack informed us of the upcoming Mt. Hope Christmas parade and upcoming activities. The parade will be on December 16th this year at 6pm on Main Street, in downtown Mt. Hope. This community event and activities are open to the public.

12/17/23 – Today's guest is Mr. Joh Wyatt, who is locally known as "The Appalachian." Mr. Wyatt discussed the Appalachian culture at Christmastime, which we see throughout the years. Many cultural nuances have been around since the 1940s in the Appalachian area. Wyatt is a historian, minister, radio personality, musician, and expert on Appalachian culture.

12/24/23 – Today's guest is Lori McKinney, who is joining us on behalf of the Princeton Renewal Committee. McKinney talked about their annual New Year's Eve celebration. The Fire Department has a special lift truck that drops the reflecting ball for the midnight countdown. This downtown celebration involves entertainment acts and many street vendors. This family celebration is a must attend event for the community.

12/31/23 – Today's guest is Cindy Whitlock, who is the spokesperson for New River Health. New River Health is a vast networks of sixteen health centers in Fayette and Nicholas Counties. Whitlock discussed the new health center which is located in the old K-Mart building in Oak Hill. It took around two years to convert the building and there are many things offered to residents. The building now hosts various healthcare provider offices, and some free health services may be obtained by residents.

First Divorced Then Dead

On the morning of July 18, 2014, beloved FSU law professor and father of two young children, Dan Markel, pulled into his driveway and was approached by an unknown man who shot him twice in the head at point-blank range. Detectives found no clues about the perpetrators at the crime scene; they had only one lead to work with — a neighbor who gave a loose description of a Prius speeding out of Dan's driveway. Through a series of interviews and with aid from the FBI, police were able to uncover the travels of the Prius through a web of surveillance footage and toll booth data, which finally led to the arrest of the hitmen responsible for his death. But the question remained: Who hired the hitmen? With reporting from ABC News chief national correspondent Matt Gutman, "20/20" documents how prosecutors used newly enhanced audio as the final link to charge Dan's ex-wife's brother, Charlie Adelson, with the crime. The two-hour program features an exclusive interview with June Umchinda, Charlie Adelson's exgirlfriend, and additional interviews with Ruth and Phil Markel, Dan's parents, and Michael Weinstein, a former family friend.

The One That Got Out

When authorities found Melissa Ramirez and Claudine Luera murdered and abandoned on the outskirts of Laredo, Texas, they came to a terrifying conclusion over the similarities between the two crime scenes: the city's red-light district had become the hunting ground of a serial killer. How many more women would become victims? In a new "20/20," ABC News correspondent John Quiñones reports on the investigation that ultimately led to one of their own, border patrol supervisor Juan David Ortiz, who was assisting on the case. "20/20" also examines key witness testimony and police body camera video, as well as unpacks Ortiz's nearly nine-hour interrogation that led to his shocking confession.

Diary of a Killer

When Angela Bledsoe — a beloved mother and successful financial analyst — is found dead in her home in an upscale New Jersey suburb, all eyes turn toward her longtime boyfriend James Ray III. After abruptly leaving their young daughter in the care of his brother, the high-powered lawyer and former police officer skipped town and led investigators on an international chase. In a new "20/20," co-anchor Deborah Roberts reports on the shocking twists and turns of the case, including the investigation that led FBI agents to Cuba, where Ray was apprehended in a rare extradition case.

Disney 100: A Century of Dreams - A Special Edition of 20/20

Friday, December 15, 2023

All American Murder

Antonio Armstrong — a former NFL player turned successful business owner — and his wife, Dawn Armstrong, raised what seemed to be a picture-perfect Texas family. But on a fateful night in July 2016, everything changed when their then-16-year-old son AJ called 911 and reported that he heard gunshots from his parents' room. When police arrived, they found Dawn dead and Antonio fighting for his life — a fight he soon lost — and authorities singled out AJ as the prime suspect. Almost a decade later, the case has gone to trial twice, each time ending in a hung jury. However, bombshell new evidence, previously overlooked, upended the case and finally brought a legal resolution. In a new "20/20," ABC News chief national correspondent Matt Gutman takes viewers inside AJ Armstrong's third murder trial and provides an inside look at the evidence that went undiscovered for seven years. The episode includes interviews with Harris County prosecutors John Jordan and Ryan Trask, retired Houston Police Department Detective Jimmy Dodson, defense attorneys Rick Detoto and Chris Collings, and AJ Armstrong, in which he denies any involvement in the murders and describes what he claims really happened in the house that night.

The Deadly Ride

Jason Dalton, a former Uber driver, terrorized the city of Kalamazoo, Michigan, for eight horrific hours on Feb. 20, 2016, killing six people and seriously injuring two others. "20/20" presents a two-hour episode on his crime spree and puzzling explanation to police, featuring interviews with surviving victims, relatives of victims, law enforcement and others who crossed paths with him on that tragic day. ABC News chief national correspondent Matt Gutman sits down for emotional interviews with Dalton's two surviving victims: Abbie Kopf, who miraculously survived after she was shot in the head at age 14 and her heart stopped, and Tiana Carruthers, a young mother shot in her condominium complex while shielding children from the gunfire. Both Abbie and Tiana open up about their encounters with Dalton, their injuries and how life has progressed. (OAD: 2/22/19)

When Shele Covlin — a 47-year-old mother of two and successful banker — is found dead in her bathtub in her apartment on the Upper West Side of Manhattan, it seems at first like a tragic accident. But family members quickly grow suspicious of her estranged husband, Rod Covlin, especially after authorities exhume her body and come to a shocking conclusion: Shele was strangled. "20/20," co-anchor Deborah Roberts reports on the secrets uncovered during the years-long investigation, ranging from allegations of domestic abuse to the revelation that Shele had decided to cut Rod out of her multimillion-dollar will just a day before authorities found her dead, that eventually put Rod behind bars.
