## Forum

Forum is a locally produced public affairs show, which addresses various topics and issues of community importance. Forum airs on Sunday mornings at 11:30am. The following list details the weekly topic(s) and a brief summary of community information provided by the guest.

Please note, due to Governor Justice's stay-at-home orders amidst concerns of covid-19 transmission, Forum did not air original episodes for the following dates: 4/5/20, 4/12/20, 4/19/20, and 4/26/20. Episodes included up-coming Memorial Day weekend festivals as well as the role of a local hospital during the pandemic.

5/3/20: Melanie Terry joined us today. Ms. Terry is the Director for "One Voice," of Beckley. One Voice is a non-profit faith based charity that has been in operation for fourteen years on the WVU Tech campus. The organization serves five area counties of southern West Virginia. The primary function of One Voice is to provide awareness and assist citizens involved in opioid and substance abuse situations.

5/10/20: Today's guest was Ms. Dee Sizemore, the Community Outreach Liaison for Beckley Appalachian Regional Hospital. Ms. Sizemore continued her discussion from previous Forum episodes concerning the problem of vaping amongst young people. Sizemore states that seventeen students have already died from vaping, and vaping is a growing concern among students. Dr. Amjad also discussed medical implications that come along with vaping.

5/17/20: Today, viewers had an opportunity to learn more about local history with our guest, Sherry Brake. Ms. Brake is a Paranormal Investigator who has authored nine books concerning paranormal activity. Ms. Brake has written about activity in castles, old prisons, and two of her books were focused on the prison at Moundsville. Ms. Brake is a popular lecturer and tour guide for many locations known to have paranormal activity.

5/24/20: Today's guest, Amelia Courts, is the President and CEO of Education Alliance of West Virginia. This is a statewide non-profit group with the goal of bringing area businesses

together with education in order to help schools throughout the state. The association helps the school systems in numerous ways, including financially. The association recently celebrated their 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

5/31/20: Today’s Forum guest is Karen Reed, a licensed pharmacist for New River Health. Ms. Reed provided information about the New River Health system, which serves both Fayette and Nicholas counties. New River Health has seven offices, including clinics. Dental centers, pharmacies, and health centers help serve low income families in the area. Recently, New River Health opened a new dental clinic in Mt. Hope. Future plans include developing an abandoned K-mart store in Oak Hill and transforming it into a health complex.

6/7/20: Mr. John Wyatt, also known as “The Appalachian” joined us today to discuss Appalachian culture. Mr. Wyatt primarily discussed the town of Rainelle, where is involved with the City Council. He talked extensively about the origin of Rainelle and other similar, small towns in West Virginia. Mr. Wyatt informed viewers about a historical society that is starting which will seek to preserve and educate the public about the Appalachian culture.

6/14/20: Today’s guest on Forum was Mr. Ron Cantley, who is the Executive Director of the Raleigh County Community Action. The organization offers community support in main areas: housing, pre-school head start, transportation, and the homeless shelter. A bus system provides transportation for area residents to facilitate appointments and shopping. The Pine Haven homeless shelter serves many area families in need. Rent supplements and assistance with low-income housing are other ways the organization serves the community.

6/21/20: Ms. Vickie Webb joins us today, as she is the Project Director for the Community Transformation Project. This training program is held every Saturday in East Beckley to facilitate young people and their ability to obtain employment. Areas of training include robotics, computers, engineering, and banking. A major goal of the project is to spark an interest for young people into obtaining a college degree. The City of Beckley funds utility bills and there are also government grants to assist with funding.

6/28/20: Amelia Courts joins us today as the President and CEO of the Education Alliance. The Alliance is a statewide non-profit with the goal of bringing areas businesses together with education in order to assist schools throughout the state. The Education Alliance has been operating for thirty-five years and helps schools in various ways, including financially.
