"Career Awareness;" Student Outreach Program: Throughout the reporting period, KSAZ/KUTP, conducts student outreach programs to various elementary, high schools and colleges to promote broadcast objectives and careers opportunities. KSAZ/KUTP participated in three events held at local elementary to promote literacy-reading programs and broadcast careers, one News Anchor attended each event. In addition, a Producer spoke at an elementary school class about his job as a news producer.

American Corporate Partners (ACP): FOX participates in ACP's Veteran Mentoring Program connects Veteran Protégés with Corporate Mentors for a yearlong mentorship. Paired based on their career objectives and professional experience, Mentors and Protégés define the goals of their mentorship together and focus on a successful transition from the military to the civilian workforce through training, coaching and job development skills.

Job Shadow Students Outreach Program: KSAZ/KUTP hosts students, throughout the year, from various valley high schools or Colleges. The students spend the day(s) learning the operations of all the station's departments. They have an opportunity to view a "behind-the-scenes" production.

Employee Enrichment/Training: KSAZ/KUTP conducts employee training throughout the reporting cycle. This training included; Lithium Battery safety & handling, Share Rocket, CMS Introduction, Salesforce Email Newsletters, Chyron Prime training, and Live Truck training. Such training prepares employees with leading-edge industry technological advancements.

"Career Awareness;" Station Tours: Throughout the reporting period, KSAZ/KUTP, conducts station tours for various community/educational organizations to explain television broadcast operations. One tour of Arizona State University Walter Cronkite School of Journalism students was held during this reporting period.

Minority Training/Scholarship Programs: Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media – Established in 1989, the Emma L. Bowen Foundation for Minority Interests in Media is a non-profit organization whose mission is to create career opportunities in the media industry for minority youth through a program that focuses on scholastic achievement, direct work experience and professional development. Students in the program work in media companies each summer and during school breaks, from high school through college. The students earn both salaries and matching scholarship funds to be used for college tuition and related expenses. Over a period of up to five years, the students experience numerous aspects of corporate operation and develop professional and practical skills that will help prepare them for their careers, many of which begin at the companies where the students interned. Fox Television Stations have been a corporate partner in this program since its inception and two of the Company's executives are on the Foundation's Board. KSAZ/KUTP selected a college freshman to receive this opportunity. The student was hired during her freshman college year to work in various departments. The student was given an opportunity to work fulltime during the summers and part-time during the college school year, while still receiving training. KSAZ/KUTP matches all earned income and applies the same to the college tuition obligation for the student. The student works throughout her college years and has the opportunity to get a job at the station upon graduation, if available. The student during this reporting period was an Asian-American female in her senior year at Arizona State University. She was offered full-time employment with KSAZ in March 2020 and has since graduated from the program.
