SWCC provides direct services to primary and secondary survivors and victims of domestic violence, sexual assault, sex trafficking, labor trafficking, sexual harassment, stalking, and child abuse. They are the initial contact for victims in crisis through our 24-hour safe line as well as through referrals from law enforcement, medical personnel, court administration, and other agencies such as churches, health and human service groups, and mental health centers; many victims also “walk-in.” There are no age limitations on services. They also have a youth program which is designed to provide services, outreach and education to youth, families, schools and communities.
