“Scam Tracker” – Frank Selona of the Better Business Bureau warned the audience that even though it’s a new year, scammers are still out there. The biggest listing on their Scamtracker is a Credit card scam with your credit card info obtained from a charity you may have donated to. He advised to closely watch your credit card statement for donations to a charity that you didn’t make. The scammers can redirect those funds to themselves. The charges will likely start small for a dollar or two but once the scammer sees that the charges are going through, they’ll charge a high ticket item. So keep a close watch on your credit card statements!
