Editorial 11/9 \$900 Million Loan

WE'VE ALL SEEN THE STORIES. OUR ECONOMY IS A MESS. IF YOU'RE IN DENIAL, JUST CHECK OUT THE NUMBERS. ILLINOIS' UNEMPLOYMENT RATE SKYROCKETED TO 10-POINT-5 PERCENT IN SEPTEMBER - THAT'S THE HIGHEST RATE SINCE 19-83! OUR GREAT STATE HAS LOST MORE THAN 356-THOUSAND JOBS SINCE THE ONSET OF THE RECESSION AND IT DOESN'T LOOK LIKE ANY END IS IN SIGHT. THE HOME FORCLOSURE RATE HAS GONE UP 25-PERCENT IN THE LAST YEAR. FRESH FROM PROPOSING A PLAN TO BORROW 900-MILLION DOLLARS, GOVERNOR PAT QUINN HAS DONE IT AGAIN. ON FRIDAY - GOVERNOR QUINN SIGNED A PLAN TO RAISE FEES FOR HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES.
